1. Max felt (hope) _____ when he lost his favourite banana. (Add a suffix) (1 mark)

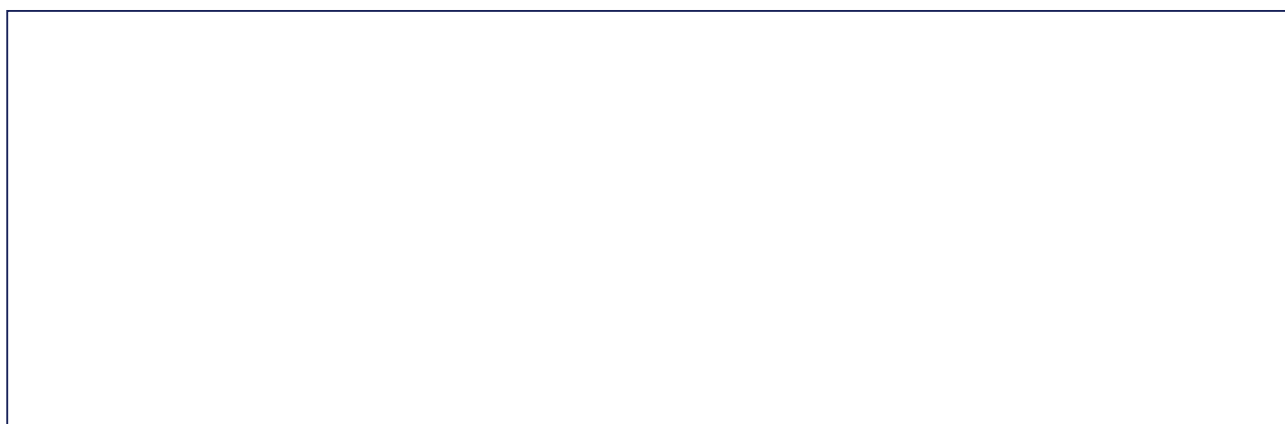
2. It is (fair) _____ that the monkey had to share his fruit. (Add a prefix) (1 mark)
