- Every sentence must start with a tall, proud capital letter.
- A full stop is a tiny dot that goes at the end of a sentence to show it is finished.
- When you ask someone a question, you must use a curly question mark at the end.
- Use an exclamation mark if your sentence is shouting with excitement or surprise!
- Always check your work to make sure your punctuation marks are in the right place.

Did you know? Did you know? Punctuation acts like a set of traffic lights for your writing! A full stop is like a red light telling the reader to stop and take a breath, while a question mark asks the reader to think, and an exclamation mark shows that a sentence is full of excitement!
