

Pip's Punctuation Party

Learning objective: To recognise and use full stops and capital letters to demarcate sentences.

Help Pip the bookworm fix his messy story! Use a capital letter at the start of every sentence and a full stop at the end. Remember, names like Pip also need a capital letter.

Word bank: Pip · the · sat · on · a · big · red · leaf · ate · lunch

1. Sentence 1: Write a sentence about Pip the caterpillar. Remember your capital letter and full stop. (2 marks)

2. Sentence 2: Write a sentence about something Pip likes to eat. Don't forget the full stop! (2 marks)

3. Sentence 3: Write a sentence about where Pip is sitting. Use a capital letter at the start. (2 marks)

4. Check your work: Circle every capital letter you have used with a blue crayon. (2 marks)

5. Check your work: Put a green dot next to every full stop you have used. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you add an exclamation mark to the end of your favourite sentence to show Pip is feeling excited?
