

Max's Sentence Scramble

Learning objective: To use capital letters and full stops to demarcate sentences, and to arrange words into a coherent order.

Max the monkey has mixed up his word cards! A proper sentence must start with a capital letter and end with a full stop. Look at the word bank provided for each question, then write the sentence out correctly on the lines below. Remember to check your capital letters and full stops!

Word bank: the · monkey · eats · a · banana · Max · is · happy · jumps · high · He · likes · to · climb · trees

1. 1. Scramble these words: monkey / the / a / eats / banana. (2 marks)

2. 2. Scramble these words: happy / Max / is. (2 marks)

3. 3. Scramble these words: high / jumps / He. (2 marks)

4. 4. Scramble these words: to / climb / likes / He / trees. (2 marks)

5. 5. Write your own sentence about Max the monkey using a capital letter and a full stop. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey sitting in a tree eating his favourite snack.



Extension challenge: Can you add an adjective to one of your sentences to describe the monkey? For example, instead of 'The monkey eats a banana', you could write 'The cheeky monkey eats a yellow banana'.
