

Meet My New Friend: A Character Profile

Learning objective: To use capital letters, full stops, and conjunctions to write simple sentences describing a character.

Today, we are going to help Pip the bookworm write a description of a new friend! Follow the boxes below to build your sentences. Remember to start each sentence with a capital letter and finish with a full stop. Try to use the word 'and' to join two ideas together.

Word bank: kind · happy · brave · funny · clever · gentle · and · because · but

1. Name and Appearance: Write the name of your character and describe what they look like. (e.g., The lion has soft fur.) (2 marks)

2. Likes and Hobbies: What does your character enjoy doing? Use 'and' to join two things they like. (2 marks)

3. Personality: What is your character like? Are they kind or funny? Write a sentence explaining why. (2 marks)

4. Special Skill: Does your character have a secret talent? Tell me what they can do. (2 marks)

5. Sentence Check: Read your sentences out loud. Did you remember to use a capital letter at the start and a full stop at the end? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Can you write one more sentence about your character using the word 'because' to explain why they are special?
