

Max and the Sentence Builders

Learning objective: To understand how to write simple, coherent sentences by using capital letters, finger spaces, and full stops.

Help Max the monkey organise his word collection! Read the words in the bank and follow the instructions for each question to build perfect sentences.

Word bank: Max · eats · a · big · banana · The · sun · is · hot · leaps · tree · in

1. Look at these words: [eats / banana / Max / a]. Write them in the correct order to make a sentence. Remember your capital letter and full stop. (2 marks)

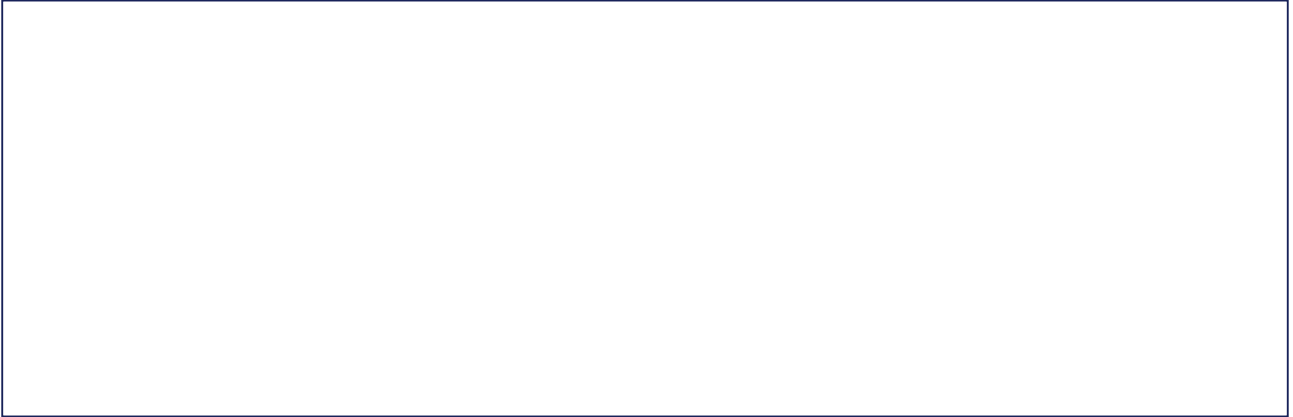
2. Find the mistake in this sentence: 'the sun is hot.' Write the sentence out again correctly. (2 marks)

3. Max wants to say he leaps in a tree. Write a sentence using those four words. (2 marks)

4. Add a full stop to the end of this sentence: 'Pip reads a book' (1 mark)

5. Write your own short sentence about Ellie the elephant. Remember to use a capital letter at the start and a full stop at the end. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Max the monkey sitting under a tree eating a snack. Label your drawing with one simple sentence.



Extension challenge: Can you write two sentences that describe what your favourite BookFlik character is doing today? Remember: Capital letter, finger spaces, and a full stop!
