

Pip the Caterpillar's Word Garden

Learning objective: To practise blending sounds and spelling simple CVC (consonant-vowel-consonant) words by matching them to their pictures.

Pip the Caterpillar has been busy collecting words in the garden! Look at the pictures below. Say the sounds in each word out loud slowly (e.g., c-a-t). Find the correct word in the word bank and write it neatly on the lines next to the matching picture.

Word bank: sun · hat · dog · pen · cup · pig

1. A bright yellow object in the sky: s _ _ (1 mark)

2. Something you wear on your head: h _ _ (1 mark)

3. A friendly pet that likes to bark: d _ _ (1 mark)

4. A tool you use for writing: p _ _ (1 mark)

5. Something you use to drink water: c _ _ (1 mark)

6. A pink animal that likes mud: p _ _ (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Pip the Caterpillar sitting on a leaf, holding a tiny pencil. Give Pip a colourful scarf!

Extension challenge: Can you think of a new word that ends with the 'at' sound, just like 'hat'? Try to sound it out and write it on the back of your sheet.
