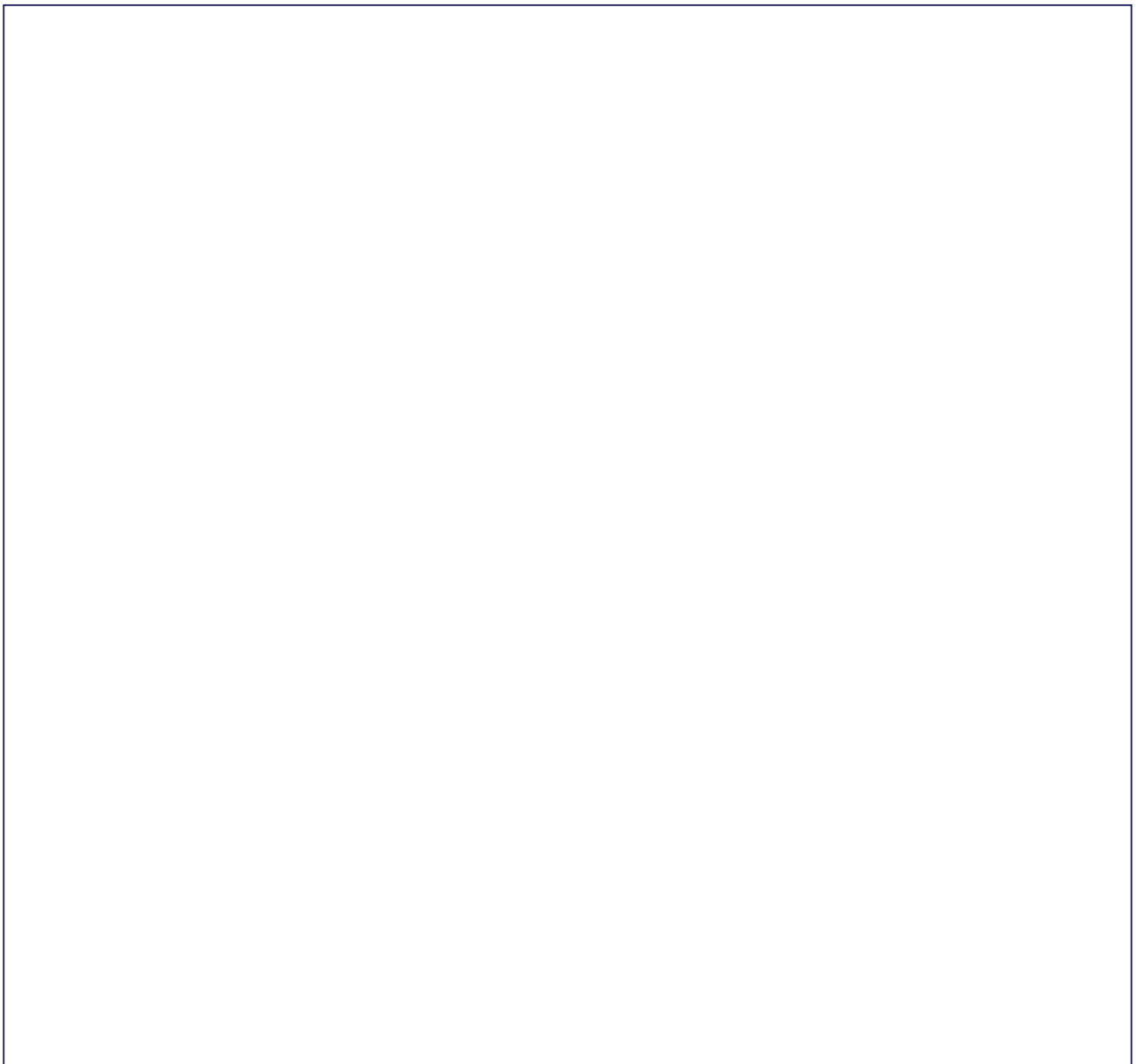


Pip the Bookworm's Story Adventure

Learning objective: To identify key features of a storybook and practise labelling parts of a scene.

Colour in the scene below! Look at the picture and use the labels to show where the different parts of a storybook are. Talk to your grown-up about your favourite story.
