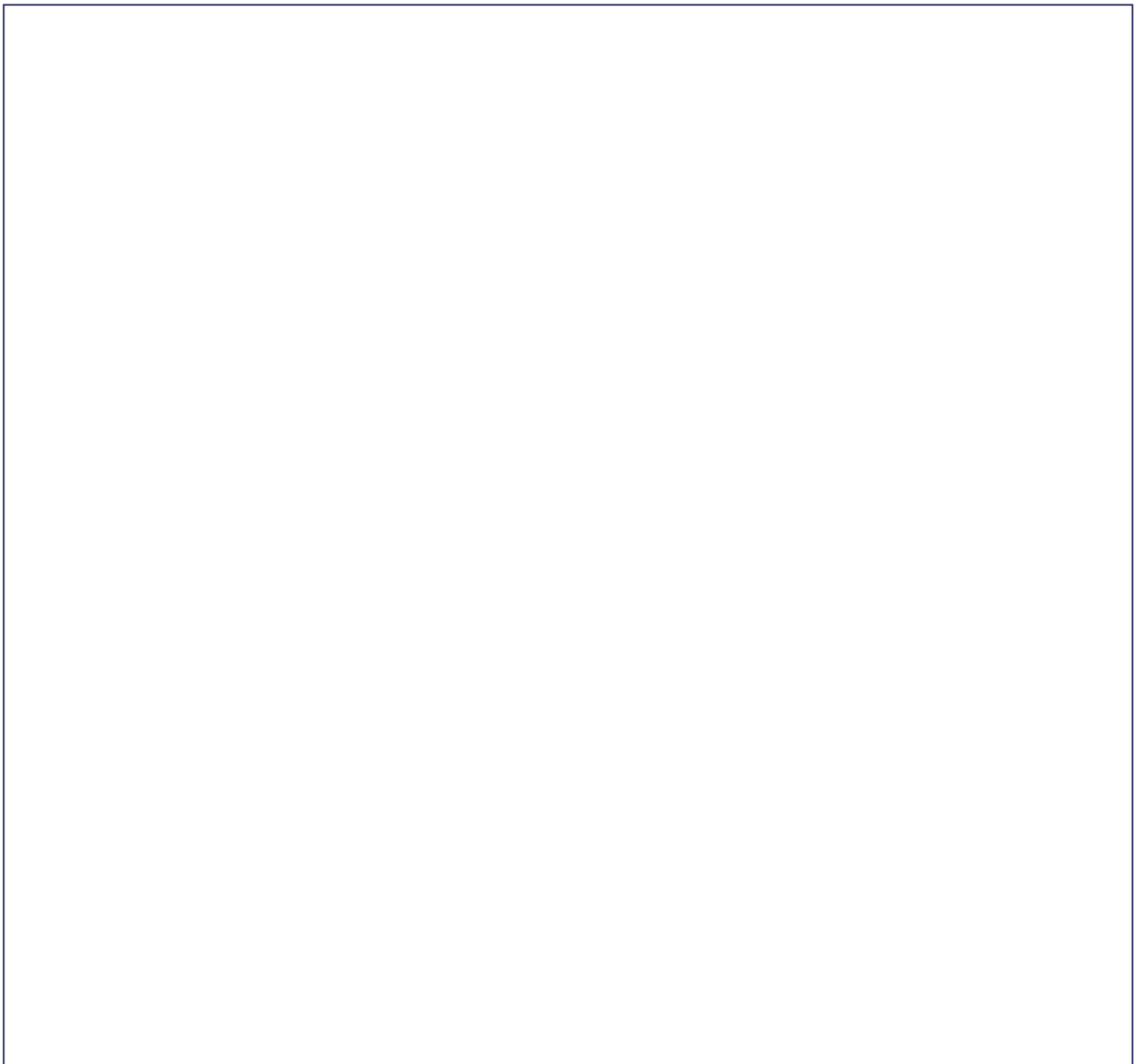


Pip's Magnificent Word Garden

Learning objective: To identify and use descriptive vocabulary to label items in a scene.

Help Pip the bookworm caterpillar tend to the word garden! Colour in the scene and use the labels provided to name the special things growing in the garden. Can you add your own creative adjectives to describe the plants?
