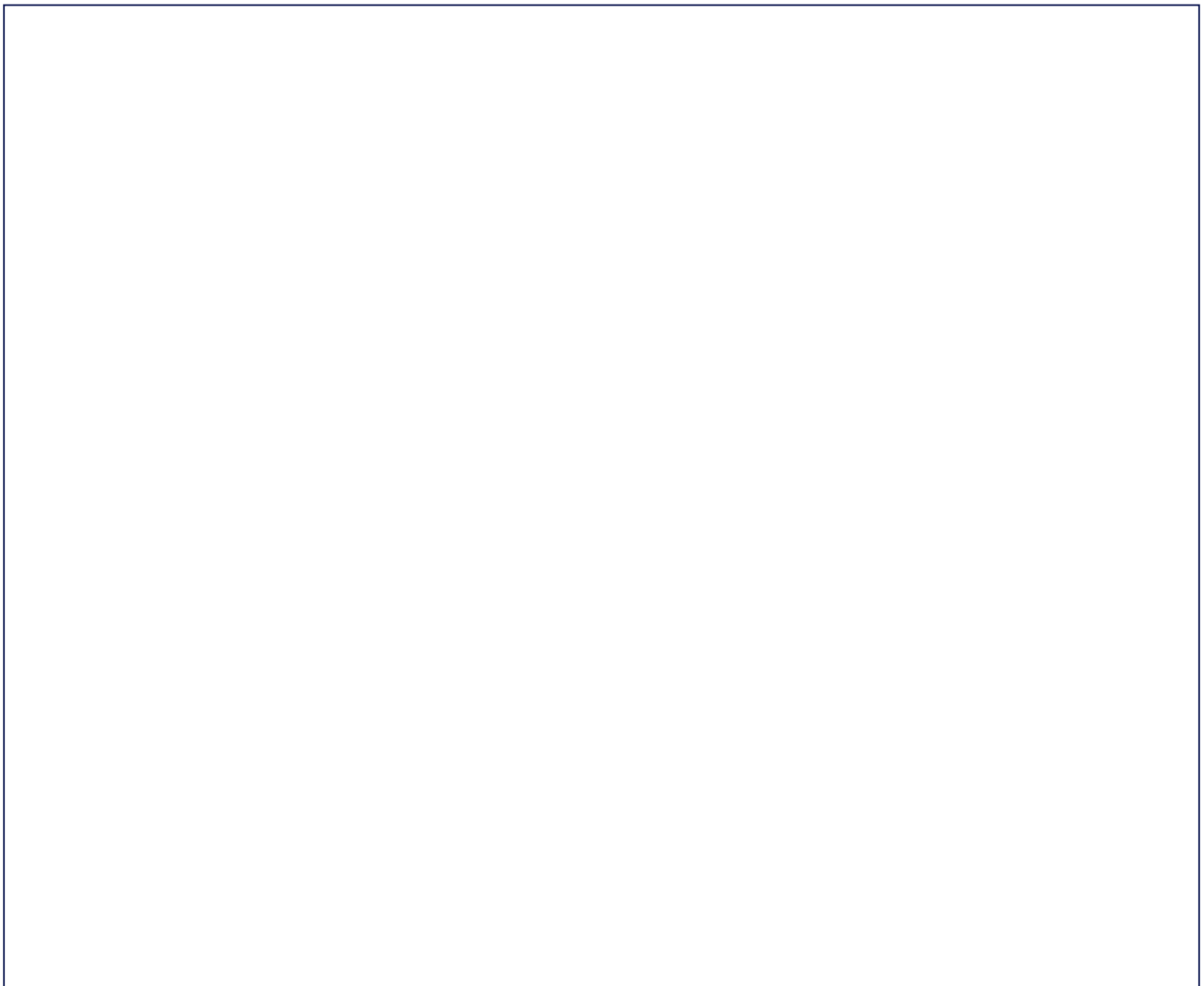


Pip's Magnificent Garden of Words

Learning objective: To build vocabulary by using descriptive adjectives to label a scene.

Pip the caterpillar is visiting a magical garden. Use the word bank to help you label your drawing and add your own descriptive words to make the scene come to life!

Draw: Draw a large, colourful garden scene. Include Pip the caterpillar as the main character. Make sure to draw a big flower, a green leaf, and at least one tiny object. Use your pencil to sketch, then use bright colours to fill in your garden. Label your items with the adjectives provided in the word bank to show how things look, feel, or move.



Label words: shimmering · enormous · vibrant · tiny · crunchy · glistening

Steps:

1. Draw a large, vibrant flower in the centre of your page. Label one part of the flower using a word from the word bank.
2. Draw Pip the caterpillar crawling on a leaf. Write one word to describe how Pip is moving (e.g., slowly, wiggly).
3. Draw something 'tiny' near Pip. What is it? Write its name next to your drawing.
4. Choose one word from the word bank and write a sentence about your garden.
5. If Pip found a shiny pebble in the garden, what would you call it? Write your own descriptive adjective.
