Learning objective: To identify and understand new vocabulary within a narrative text.

Read the story carefully and answer the questions below using full sentences.

1. Where does Pip keep the words he finds? (2 marks)

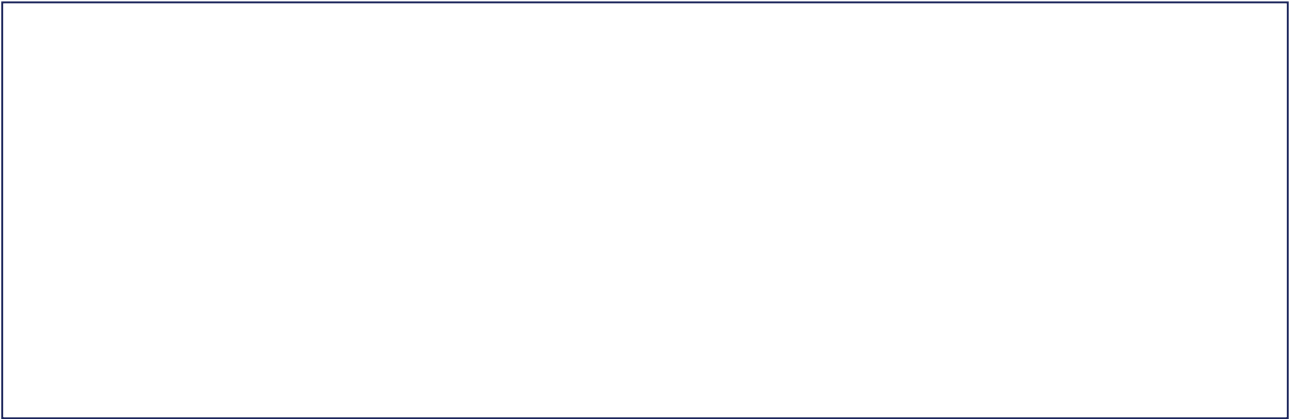
2. What is Pip's favourite word in the story? (2 marks)
