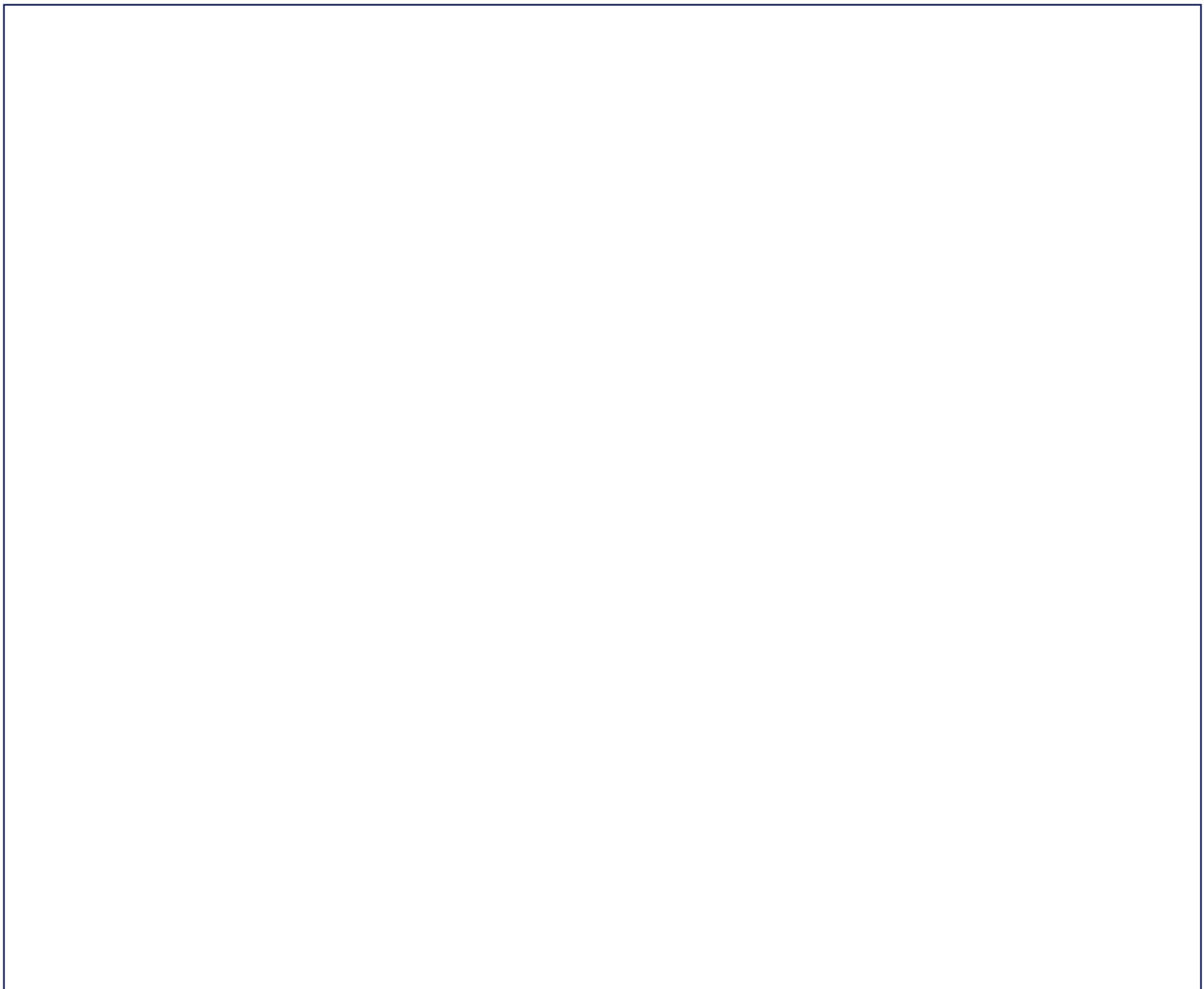


Pip's Magnificent Word Garden

Learning objective: To use descriptive vocabulary to enhance a drawing and label features using adjectives and nouns.

Pip the bookworm caterpillar is growing a garden where the flowers are made of beautiful, exciting words! Use the word bank to help you draw and label your own magical garden scene.

Draw: Draw a whimsical garden scene. Include a large central flower, a small insect, and a tall tree. The style should be bright and cheerful, using clear lines. Ensure there is space around the objects for the children to write their labels clearly.



Label words: dazzling · enormous · shimmering · tiny · vibrant · fragrant · fluttering · sparkling

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, 'shimmering' flower in the middle of the garden. Label one part of the flower using an adjective from the word bank.
2. Step 2: Draw a 'tiny' insect near the flower. Write a sentence to describe what the insect is doing.
3. Step 3: Add an 'enormous' tree to the background. Which word from the bank would you use to describe the leaves? Write it here.
4. Step 4: Think of one new 'describing word' (adjective) that is not in the word bank and write it next to your drawing of the sun.

5. Step 5: Why did you choose the word 'vibrant' to describe one of your flowers? Explain your choice.
