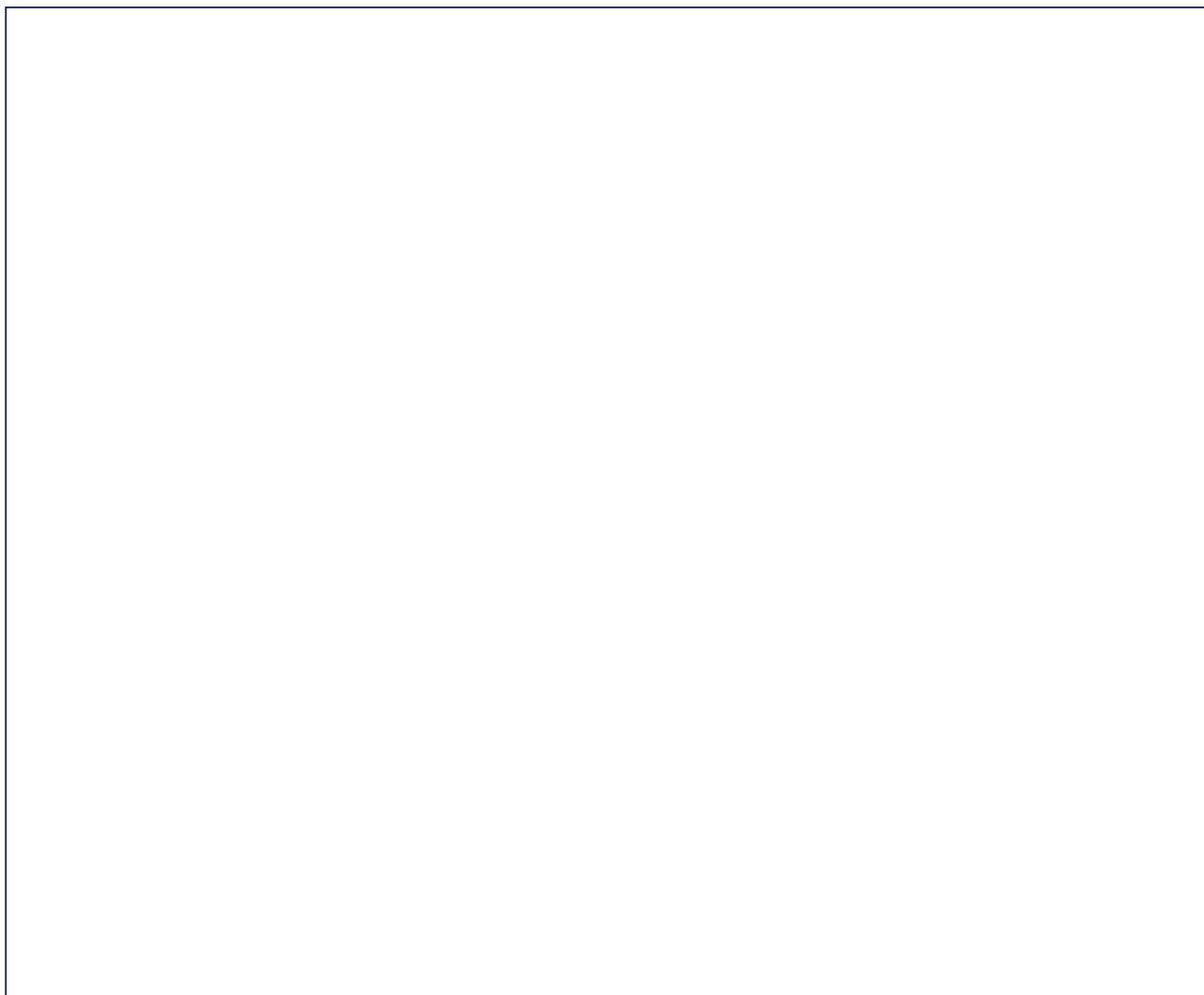


Pip's Word Garden

Learning objective: To use descriptive vocabulary to enhance a drawing and demonstrate understanding of adjectives and nouns.

Pip the bookworm caterpillar is growing a magical garden of words! Read the word bank below. Use these words to help you draw and label a vibrant, imaginative garden scene. Make sure your drawing matches the meaning of the words you choose.

Draw: Create a detailed garden scene on a landscape piece of paper. Include a large, towering plant as the focal point. Add at least one shimmering insect or small animal near the ground. Use colour to show that the garden is vibrant. Include space for labels to be written clearly with arrows pointing to specific parts of your drawing.



Label words: vibrant · fragrant · towering · scurrying · shimmering · delicate · rugged · enormous

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a 'towering' plant in the centre of your page. What does it look like? Label one part of it.
2. Step 2: Draw a 'shimmering' creature near the base of your plant. Describe its movement in one sentence.
3. Step 3: Choose two adjectives from the word bank. Write them next to items in your drawing that match those descriptions.
4. Step 4: If you were to sell a 'fragrant' flower from your garden for £2.50, draw a small price tag next to it.

5. Step 5: Write a short sentence explaining why you chose to draw your creature as 'scurrying'.
