

Pip's Word Collection Adventure

Learning objective: To develop vocabulary by categorising descriptive adjectives and using them to enhance sentences.

Pip the bookworm caterpillar has found some lovely new words, but they are all jumbled up! Look at the 'Word Bank' below. Help Pip sort the words into two groups: 'Words for Feelings' and 'Words for Sizes'. Then, look at the questions to help Pip finish his sentences.

Word bank: Happy · Tiny · Sad · Huge · Excited · Gigantic

1. Pip saw a very small ant. Which word from the word bank describes the ant: Tiny or Huge? (1 mark)

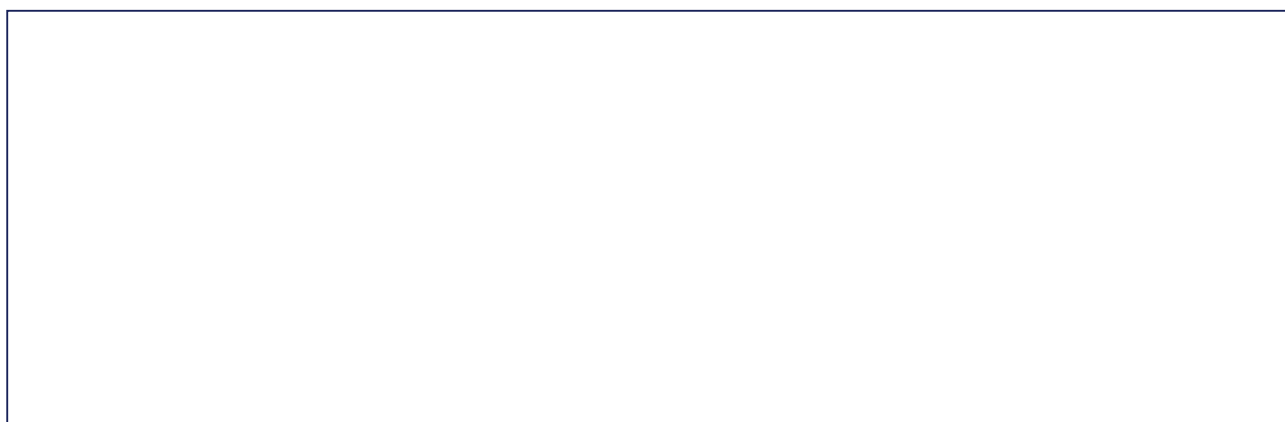
2. Pip found a big, yummy leaf. Which word describes the leaf: Tiny or Huge? (1 mark)

3. Pip is going on a trip to the park. He feels very Happy and Excited. Are these feeling words or size words? (1 mark)

4. Can you draw a line to match the feeling to the face? (Draw a smiley face next to 'Happy' and a tear-drop face next to 'Sad'). (2 marks)

5. Choose one word from the word bank and tell Pip a sentence using that word. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Pip the caterpillar sitting on a 'Huge' leaf, looking very 'Happy'.



Extension challenge: Ask a grown-up to help you find three more words at home that describe how you feel today and add them to Pip's collection!
