

Pip's Word Collection Adventure

Learning objective: To develop vocabulary by identifying, grouping, and using descriptive words to describe objects and emotions.

Help Pip the caterpillar sort his favourite words! Read the words in the word bank and complete the challenges below to help him build his story book.

Word bank: sparkly · gigantic · happy · tiny · bright · sad · soft · woolly

1. Pip found a word that means 'very big'. Can you find it in the word bank and write it here? (1 mark)

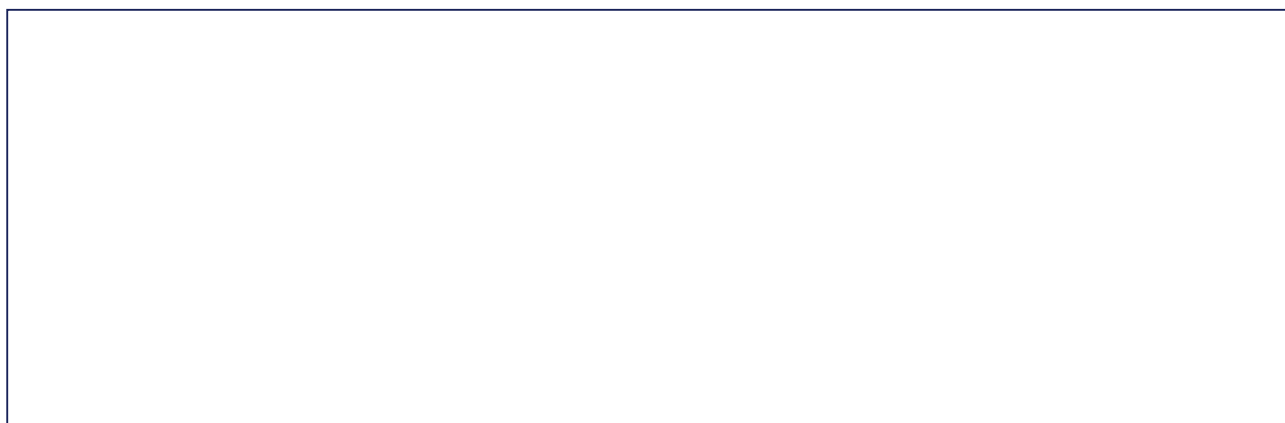
2. Look at the words 'happy' and 'sad'. These are feeling words. Can you draw a face next to each one to show what they mean? (2 marks)

3. Which word from the list would you use to describe a fluffy sheep? Write it below. (1 mark)

4. Choose one word from the bank. Use it in a short sentence to describe something you saw at the park today. (2 marks)

5. If Pip has a tiny button that costs £1, and he finds a gigantic button that costs £2, which button is the most expensive? (1 mark)
