Read each question carefully and write your answers in the spaces provided. Remember to use capital letters and full stops.

4. Pip loves collecting new words. Can you think of two adjectives to describe a magical forest in a story? (2 marks)

5. If you were writing your own book, what would the title be? (1 mark)
