Learning objective: To write a clear book review by expressing preferences and using adjectives to describe a favourite story.

Celebrate World Book Day by choosing your favourite book. Use this template to tell Pip the Bookworm all about your choice. Remember to use capital letters and full stops in your sentences.

Word bank: exciting · character · adventure · favourite · interesting · funny · story · brilliant

1. Book Title and Author: Write the name of the book you have chosen and who wrote it. (2 marks)

2. The Plot: Briefly describe what happens in the story. Can you explain the beginning, middle, and end? (4 marks)

3. My Favourite Character: Who is your favourite character and why? Use a describing word from the word bank. (3 marks)

4. Why I Recommend It: Why should someone else read this book? What did you enjoy the most? (3 marks)

5. Star Rating: If you had to buy this book in a shop for £5, would you think it was worth the money? Why? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are Pip the Bookworm. Write one sentence about why you think reading is the best way to travel to new worlds.
