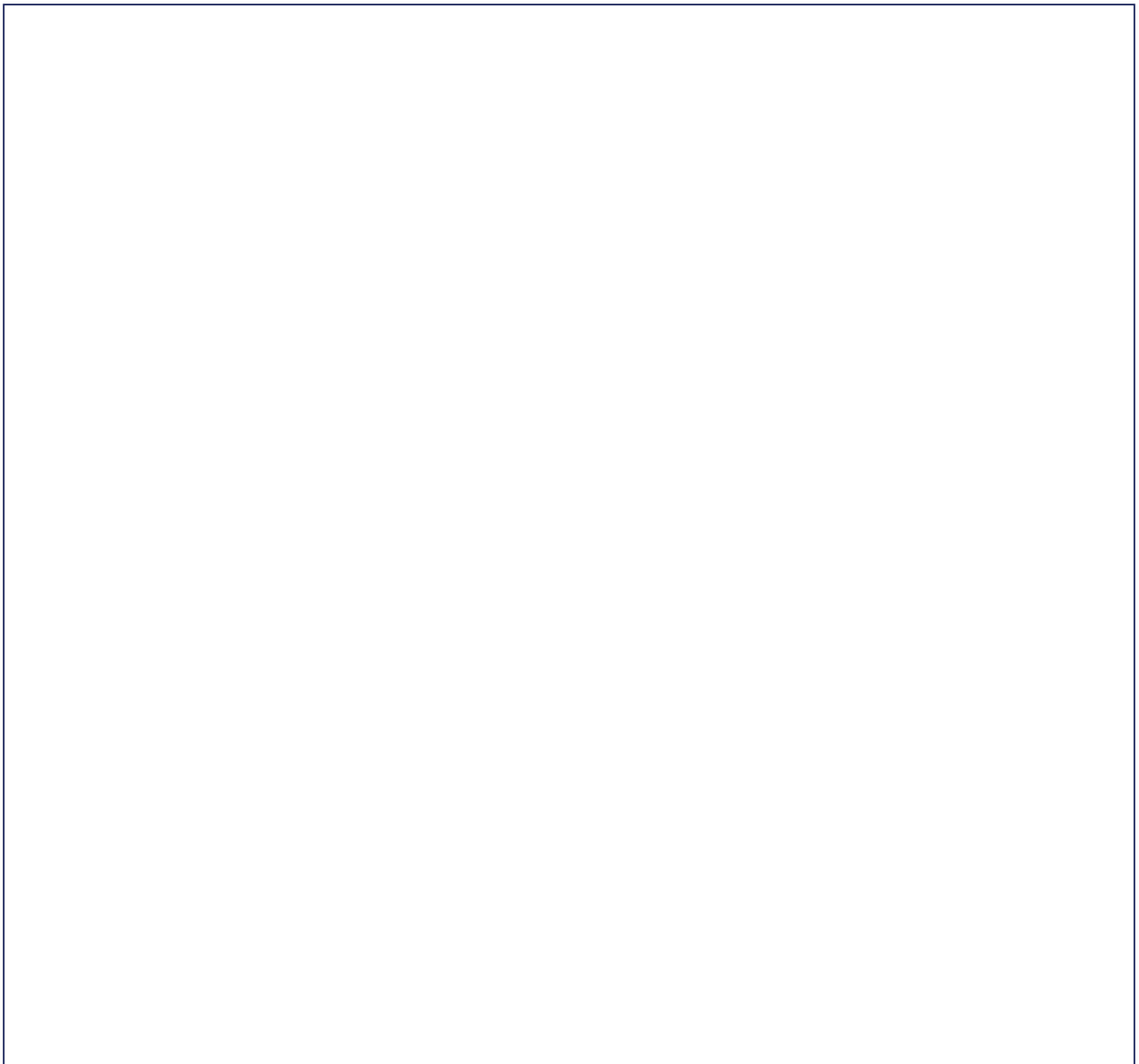


World Book Day with Pip the Bookworm

Learning objective: To engage with storytelling and print concepts while developing fine motor skills through colouring.

Colour in the picture of Pip and the books. Practise your pencil control by staying inside the lines. Read the fun facts with an adult and label the parts of the picture.

Colour this: A friendly, smiling caterpillar named Pip wearing a pair of round spectacles. Pip is curled up comfortably on a large, open storybook. Beside Pip, there is a small stack of three books of different sizes. In the background, there are a few simple stars and a small, friendly-looking moon wearing a nightcap. Use bold, clear outlines suitable for young children to colour. Ensure the pages of the open book are blank so children can draw their own simple story illustrations inside.



Steps:

1. Label the book that Pip is reading.
2. Label the caterpillar in the picture.
