

Les Animaux : Rosa's Animal Adventure!

Join Rosa the parrot on a linguistic journey! Can you master these animal names and describe your favourite creature?

- To say 'The dog is big' in French, we write: 'Le chien est grand'.
- To describe a small cat, we use the phrase: 'Le chat est petit'.
- When you see a fast horse, you can say: 'Le cheval est rapide'.
- To describe a slow rabbit, we use the words: 'Le lapin est lent'.
- Remember: French nouns for animals have a gender; 'un' is for masculine, and 'une' is for feminine.

Did you know? Did you know? In French, when we talk about animals, we often use the word 'un' for masculine nouns or 'une' for feminine nouns. For example, a lion is 'un lion', but a giraffe is 'une girafe'. Rosa loves learning these gender patterns because it's like solving a secret code!
