

Rosa the Parrot's French Body Parts Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and name parts of the body in French and use them in simple sentences.

Help Rosa the parrot learn her body parts! Look at the word bank and complete the activities below to show what you have learnt.

Word bank: la tête (head) · les yeux (eyes) · le nez (nose) · la bouche (mouth) · les oreilles (ears) · le bras (arm) · la main (hand) · la jambe (leg) · le pied (foot)

1. Rosa is describing her face. Fill in the missing French words: 'J'ai un nez, deux _____ (eyes) et deux _____ (ears).' (2 marks)

2. Translate these phrases into English: 'La main' and 'La jambe'. (2 marks)

3. If you were a robot, you might have two of everything! Write the French for 'two feet' using the word bank. (1 mark)

4. Which body part is 'la tête'? Draw a quick sketch to show you know the meaning. (2 marks)

5. Complete the sentence: 'J'ai un bras' means 'I have one _____.' (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a funny monster and label four of its body parts using the French words from the word bank (e.g., draw an arrow to its nose and write 'le nez').



*Extension challenge: Try to write a short sentence in French describing a monster's features. For example:
'Le monstre a une tête et deux bras.'*
