

Rosa's Parisian Puppet Show: Les Parties du Corps

Learning objective: To identify and spell key vocabulary for body parts in French and apply them to describe a character.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends build puppets for a school show! Use the word bank to label the parts of the body on the diagram below. Once you have labelled them, complete the sentences to describe what the puppets are doing.

Word bank: la tête (head) · les yeux (eyes) · le nez (nose) · la bouche (mouth) · les bras (arms) · les jambes (legs) · les pieds (feet) · le ventre (stomach)

1. The puppet is holding a baguette. Write the French word for 'arms' to complete this sentence: Le pantin utilise ses _____ pour tenir le pain. (2 marks)

2. The puppet is wearing a hat. Which French word from the list refers to the 'head'? Write it here. (2 marks)

3. The puppet is dancing. Write the French word for 'legs' to finish this sentence: Il bouge ses _____ très vite ! (2 marks)

4. If the puppet is hungry, which word from the bank should you use to point to its 'stomach'? (2 marks)

5. Describe the puppet's face. Write a sentence in French using 'les yeux' (eyes) or 'le nez' (nose) to explain what the puppet can see or smell. (4 marks)

Draw: Draw a funny puppet for Rosa's show. Label at least four body parts on your drawing using the correct French vocabulary from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Imagine your puppet has a special power! Write one extra sentence in French describing what another part of its body can do (e.g., 'Mes mains sont grandes' - My hands are big).
