

Rosa's French Body Parts Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and spell key French vocabulary for parts of the body and use them in simple sentences.

Help Rosa the parrot learn her anatomy! Use the word bank to label the body parts and complete the sentences in French. Remember to include the correct articles (le, la, or les) where needed.

Word bank: la tête (head) · les yeux (eyes) · le nez (nose) · la bouche (mouth) · les oreilles (ears) · les bras (arms) · les mains (hands) · les jambes (legs) · les pieds (feet)

1. Rosa is looking in the mirror. Match the English word to the French word: Head, Nose, Hands, Feet. (4 marks)

2. Complete the sentence: 'J'ai deux...' (I have two...). Choose two body parts from the word bank that you have two of. (2 marks)

3. Translate into French: 'My mouth and my nose.' (Hint: Use 'Ma' for feminine and 'Mon' for masculine). (2 marks)

4. If a robot had four arms, how would you write 'four arms' in French? (Hint: Use the number 'quatre'). (2 marks)

5. Rosa says 'J'ai mal à la tête.' Based on the word bank, what does Rosa have a pain in? (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a funny creature with three eyes, two noses, and four arms. Label each body part using the correct French vocabulary from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Research the French words for 'fingers' and 'shoulders'. Write a short sentence describing a monster using at least five body parts you have learned today.
