

Class 5 French Assessment: Les Vêtements (Clothes)

Learning objective: To identify, describe, and write sentences about clothing items in French, including colours and opinions.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in French where indicated. Ensure you use the correct articles (le, la, les, un, une) where appropriate.

Rosa the parrot is getting ready for a party. She looks in her wardrobe and picks out a bright red dress and comfortable blue shoes. She says, 'Aujourd'hui, je porte une robe rouge et des chaussures bleues. C'est magnifique!'

Word bank: un pull (jumper) · une chemise (shirt) · un pantalon (trousers) · une jupe (skirt) · des chaussures (shoes) · une robe (dress) · bleu (blue) · rouge (red) · vert (green) · jaune (yellow) · préféré (favourite) · je porte (I am wearing)

1. Translate the following items into French, including the correct article (e.g., un/une): 1. A jumper, 2. A skirt. (2 marks)

2. Rosa says, 'Je porte un pantalon.' What does this mean in English? (2 marks)

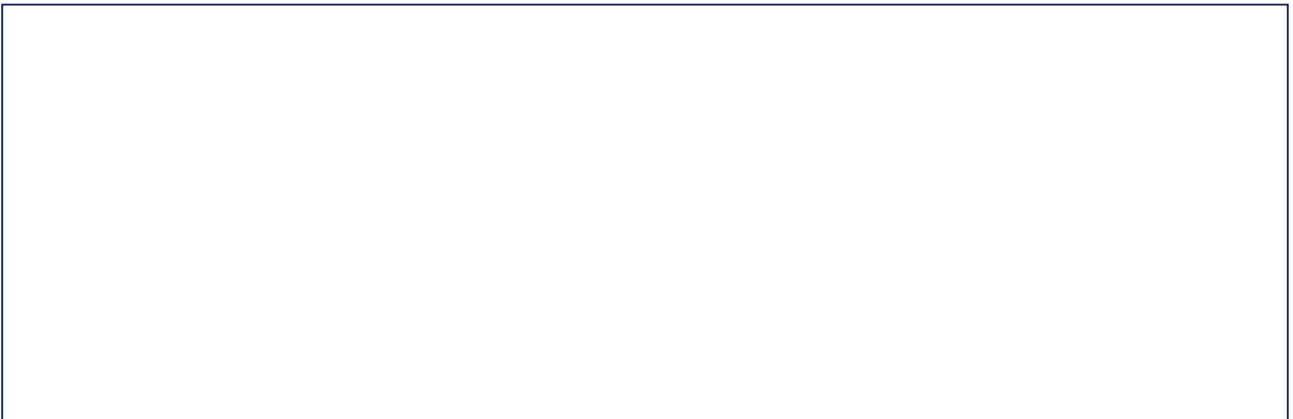
3. If you are wearing a green shirt, how would you write this in French? (Remember: the colour comes after the noun and must match the gender if necessary). (3 marks)

4. Complete the sentence: 'Mon vêtement préféré est...' (My favourite item of clothing is...) and explain why you like it using one adjective (e.g., confortable - comfortable, beau - beautiful). (4 marks)

5. Look at the list of clothes: 'une robe', 'des chaussures', 'un pantalon'. Explain why 'des' is used before 'chaussures' but not before 'robe'. (4 marks)

6. Extended Writing Task: Rosa is going to the park. Write 5 sentences in French describing what she is wearing and what the weather is like. (e.g., I am wearing..., It is sunny/cold...). (10 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot wearing an outfit of your choice. Label at least three items of clothing in French.
