

Rosa's French Fashion Show

Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for common items of clothing and describe what someone is wearing.

Help Rosa the parrot get ready for her school fashion show! Use the word bank to answer the questions below and practise your French vocabulary.

Word bank: un pull (a jumper) · une chemise (a shirt) · un pantalon (trousers) · une jupe (a skirt) · des chaussures (shoes) · un manteau (a coat) · une robe (a dress) · des chaussettes (socks) · Je porte... (I am wearing...) · Il porte... (He is wearing...) · Elle porte... (She is wearing...)

1. Rosa is choosing her outfit for the stage. If she wants to wear a dress, what should she say in French? Write the sentence starting with 'Je porte...' (2 marks)

2. Max the monkey is wearing trousers and a jumper. Write a French sentence to describe his outfit using 'Il porte...' (2 marks)

3. Translate these items into English: 'des chaussures' and 'une chemise'. (2 marks)

4. If it is raining outside, which item of clothing from the word bank would you choose to wear? Write your answer in French. (1 mark)

5. Complete this sentence for yourself: 'Aujourd'hui, je porte...' (Today, I am wearing...) using one item from the word bank. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Pip the caterpillar dressed for a sunny day. Label your drawing using at least three French clothing words from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Write a short dialogue in French between two friends, Zara and Leo, discussing what they are wearing to the school party. Include at least four items of clothing.
