

Rosa's Rainbow Palette

Learning objective: To recall and correctly spell French vocabulary for colours and apply them to descriptive sentences.

Rosa the parrot has painted a beautiful, colourful scene, but she has mixed up her paint pots! Look at the French colour words in the word bank. Match the correct French word to the English description of Rosa's painting. For the final questions, use the French adjectives to complete the sentences about her artwork.

Word bank: rouge · bleu · jaune · vert · orange · violet · rose · noir · blanc · marron

1. 1. Rosa paints the bright sun in the sky. Which colour does she use? (French word) (1 mark)

2. 2. She paints the leaves on the trees. Which colour is this? (French word) (1 mark)

3. 3. The parrot's feathers are a mix of colours. Translate: 'The bird is red and blue.' (2 marks)

4. 4. Rosa paints a dark night sky. Translate: 'The sky is black.' (2 marks)

5. 5. Rosa loves flowers. Translate: 'The flower is yellow and white.' (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting in a garden. Label at least four different parts of your drawing using the correct French colour words (e.g., label the grass 'vert' or the sun 'jaune').



Extension challenge: Write two extra sentences in French describing the colours of your favourite items in your pencil case, using the structure: 'Mon/Ma [object] est [colour].'
