

Rosa's Rainbow Art Studio: French Colours Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify, spell, and use French vocabulary for colours to describe objects accurately.

Rosa the parrot has been flying over France and loves the colourful scenery! Use this fact-file to match the English colours to their French equivalents. Once you have completed the word bank, use the sections below to describe your favourite items in French.

Word bank: rouge (red) · bleu (blue) · jaune (yellow) · vert (green) · orange (orange) · violet (purple) · rose (pink) · noir (black) · blanc (white)

1. My Favourite Fruit: Name a fruit and describe its colour in French (e.g., 'La banane est jaune'). (2 marks)

2. My School Bag: List three items in your bag and write their colour in French. (3 marks)

3. The Garden Scene: If you were drawing a garden with Rosa, what colours would you use for the flowers and the sky? Write your answer in French. (3 marks)

4. Colour Patterns: Choose two colours from the word bank and create a short French sentence using 'et' (and). (2 marks)

5. Rosa's Challenge: Translate this sentence into English: 'Le ciel est bleu et le soleil est jaune.' (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to find an object in your classroom that is 'vert' and another that is 'noir'. Write a sentence for each using the structure 'Le/La [object] est [colour].'
