

## Rosa's Weekly Planner

*Learning objective: To recall and correctly spell the days of the week in French and understand their sequence.*

Help Rosa the parrot organise her busy schedule! Use the word bank to label the seven colourful feathers on Rosa's tail. Each feather represents a different day of the week, starting with Monday.

**Draw:** Draw a large, cheerful parrot named Rosa in the centre of your page. Give her a long, beautiful tail with seven distinct, large feathers fanned out. In the middle of each feather, write one of the days of the week from the word bank in a clear, neat script, starting from the top feather as Monday (*lundi*) and working your way down to Sunday (*dimanche*). Add some bright colours to her wings and maybe a little book or a pencil in her beak!



*Label words: lundi · mardi · mercredi · jeudi · vendredi · samedi · dimanche*

### Steps:

1. Write the French word for the day that comes after 'mardi'.
2. Which two days make up the 'le week-end' in France?
3. If today is 'lundi', what day is tomorrow in French?
4. Why do you think Rosa has seven feathers on her tail for this activity?
5. Translate 'dimanche' into English.
