

Rosa's Weekly Diary: Ma Semaine

Learning objective: To recall and use the days of the week in French within the context of a simple diary entry.

Rosa the parrot has been busy learning new words! Use this template to create a mini-diary. For each day, write the French word for the day, then write a short sentence in English or French about what you did that day. Remember, in French, days of the week do not start with a capital letter unless they are at the beginning of a sentence.

Word bank: lundi · mardi · mercredi · jeudi · vendredi · samedi · dimanche · Aujourd'hui · Je joue · J'étudie

1. Lundi et Mardi: Write the French word for these two days and one activity you did on each day. (2 marks)

2. Mercredi et Jeudi: Write the French word for these two days and describe how you felt on these days. (2 marks)

3. Vendredi: Write the French word for this day and explain why you are looking forward to the weekend. (2 marks)

4. Samedi et Dimanche: Write the French word for these days and list one hobby you enjoy at the weekend. (2 marks)

5. Reflection: Which day of the week is your favourite in French, and why? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Try to write a full sentence in French for each day, such as 'Lundi, je joue au football' (On Monday, I play football).
