

La Famille (My Family)

Join Rosa the parrot on a journey to learn how to talk about your family in French!

- To introduce your mother, you say 'C'est ma mère'.
- To introduce your father, you say 'C'est mon père'.
- To introduce your brother, you say 'C'est mon frère'.
- To introduce your sister, you say 'C'est ma sœur'.
- To talk about your family as a whole, you say 'Ma famille'.

Did you know? Did you know? In French, the words for 'my' change depending on the gender of the person you are talking about! We use 'mon' for masculine family members (like father and brother) and 'ma' for feminine family members (like mother and sister).
