

Rosa's French Feast: A Taste of France

Learning objective: To identify and use vocabulary related to food and drinks in French, and to express preferences using 'J'aime' and 'Je n'aime pas'.

Read the passage about Rosa the parrot's favourite market snacks. Use the word bank to help you complete the questions below.

Bonjour! I am Rosa. Today, I am visiting a busy French market. I love to fly from stall to stall to see what is for sale. For my breakfast, I buy le pain, which is always fresh and crunchy. I also see a stall selling le fromage, which smells very strong! I am feeling quite thirsty, so I buy a bottle of l'eau. For a sweet treat later, I will buy a bar of le chocolat. My friend, Max the monkey, is here too. He likes to eat la pomme, but he says, 'Je n'aime pas le fromage!' We are having a wonderful time exploring the food.

Word bank: le pain (bread) · le fromage (cheese) · la pomme (apple) · le chocolat (chocolate) · l'eau (water) · le jus d'orange (orange juice) · J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like)

1. According to the passage, what does Rosa buy to eat for her breakfast? (2 marks)

2. What does Max the monkey say he does not like? Write your answer in French. (2 marks)

3. If Rosa buys a bar of chocolate for £2.50 and a bottle of water for £1.20, how much does she spend in total? (2 marks)

4. Translate this sentence into English: 'J'aime le jus d'orange.' (1 mark)

5. If you were at the market with Rosa, which two items from the word bank would you choose to buy and why? (3 marks)

Draw: Draw Rosa the parrot sitting at a market stall. Include at least three items from the word bank on the table in front of her.



Extension challenge: Write three sentences in French about your own favourite foods. Use 'J'aime' for foods you enjoy and 'Je n'aime pas' for a food you dislike.
