

Rosa's French Greetings Fact-File

Learning objective: To learn and apply French greetings and polite phrases appropriate for different times of the day.

Join Rosa the parrot on a language adventure! Use this fact-file to organise your French greetings. Look at the word bank for help with your spellings and choose the correct phrases to suit the time of day or the person you are greeting. Write clearly in the boxes provided.

Word bank: Bonjour · Salut · Bonsoir · Au revoir · Ça va ? · Enchanté · Monsieur · Madame

1. Formal Greetings: Write a greeting you would use to be polite to an adult, such as a teacher or a shopkeeper. (2 marks)

2. Casual Greetings: Write a greeting you would use when speaking to a close friend in the playground. (2 marks)

3. Time-Sensitive Phrases: Which French greeting would you use if you arrived at a party in the evening? Explain why. (3 marks)

4. Introductions: If you were meeting someone for the first time, which phrase from the word bank would you use to say 'nice to meet you'? (2 marks)

5. The Farewell: Choose one way to say goodbye in French and write a short sentence using it, as if you are leaving the classroom. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are meeting a new friend in France. Write a short dialogue (4 lines) using at least three of the phrases from your fact-file to introduce yourself and ask how they are.
