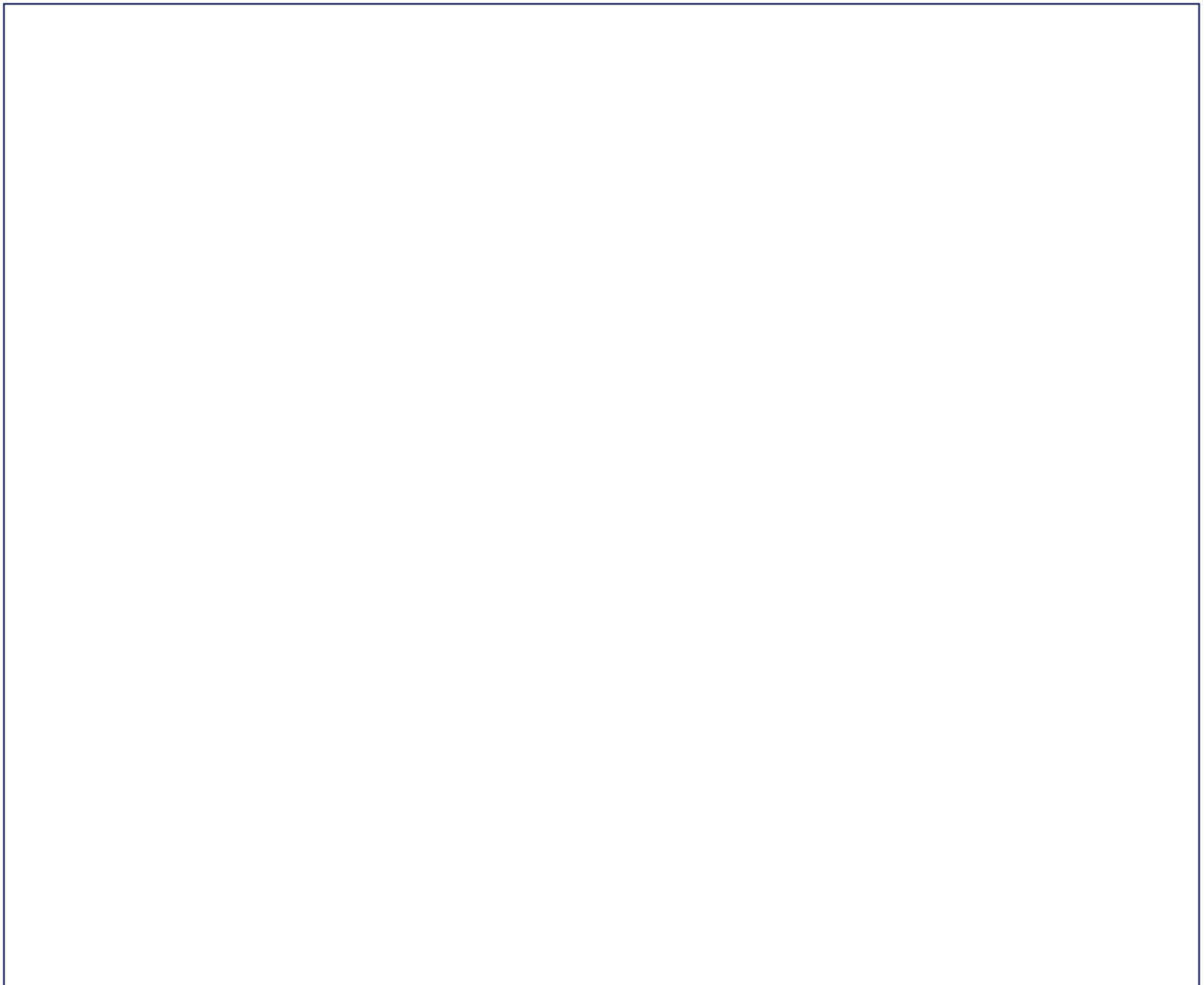


Rosa's French Number Garden

Learning objective: To accurately use and spell French numbers from 1 to 20 within a creative context.

Follow the drawing prompts to create your own French Number Garden. Use the word bank to label your illustrations correctly in French.

Draw: Create a vibrant garden scene on a landscape piece of paper. Use a cheerful, colourful style. Include a grassy meadow at the bottom and a bright blue sky at the top. Ensure there is plenty of space to draw individual items like flowers, bees, butterflies, and an apple tree, leaving room next to each group to write the corresponding French number from your word bank.



Label words: un (1) · deux (2) · trois (3) · quatre (4) · cinq (5) · six (6) · sept (7) · huit (8) · neuf (9) · dix (10)

Steps:

1. Draw exactly 'trois' (3) bright sunflowers in the corner of your garden. Label them with the correct French word.
2. Draw 'cinq' (5) bees buzzing near a hive. Write the number 'cinq' next to them.
3. Draw 'huit' (8) colourful butterflies fluttering in the sky. Label the group.
4. If you add 'deux' flowers to your 'trois' sunflowers, how many do you have in total? Write the number in French.

5. Rosa the parrot wants to count the apples on a tree. Draw a tree with 'dix' (10) apples on it and label the number.
