

Rosa's French Opinion Quiz

Learning objective: To use and recognise French opinion phrases to express likes and dislikes regarding hobbies and foods.

Join Rosa the parrot as she practises her French! Read the questions carefully and choose the correct opinion phrase. Remember, in French, we often use 'le', 'la', or 'les' after our opinion verbs.

Answer Key: 1. A, 2. True, 3. J'adore, 4. B, 5. False, 6. C, 7. J'aime, 8. D, 9. False, 10. Je déteste. Note: In Q3, Q7, and Q10, pupils may use alternative valid opinion phrases if they are grammatically correct, such as 'J'aime le chocolat'.

1. Which phrase means 'I love' in French? A) J'adore* B) Je déteste C) J'aime D) Le chat (1 mark)

2. True or False: 'Je n'aime pas' means 'I do not like'. (1 mark)

3. Translate into French: 'I love pizza'. (Use the word bank) (1 mark)

4. Which phrase is the strongest way to say you dislike something? A) Je n'aime pas B) Je déteste* C) J'aime D) J'adore (1 mark)

5. True or False: 'J'aime le football' means 'I hate football'. (1 mark)

6. If you are indifferent or dislike something, which would you use? A) J'adore B) J'aime C) Je n'aime pas* D) Bravo (1 mark)

7. Translate into French: 'I like cats'. (Use the word bank) (1 mark)

8. Which word completes the sentence: '_____ le chocolat'? A) Je B) J' C) J'adore D) Both A and C* (1 mark)

9. True or False: 'J'adore' is a weaker opinion than 'J'aime'. (1 mark)

10. Translate into French: 'I detest broccoli'. (1 mark)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting at a table with three different items: one she loves (J'adore), one she likes (J'aime), and one she hates (Je déteste). Label each item with the correct French opinion phrase.



Extension challenge: 1. Explain why it is important to include the article (le/la/les) after an opinion verb in French. 2. Compare and contrast the intensity of 'J'adore' and 'J'aime'. Justify your answer using examples. 3. What might happen to the meaning of a sentence if you accidentally swapped 'J'adore' for 'Je déteste'? 4. Write a paragraph explaining which French opinions you would use to describe your favourite and least favourite school subjects. 5. If you were teaching a friend, how would you explain the difference between 'Je n'aime pas' and 'Je déteste'? 6. Create a dialogue between yourself and Rosa where you express three different opinions about sports, ensuring you use a variety of phrases.
