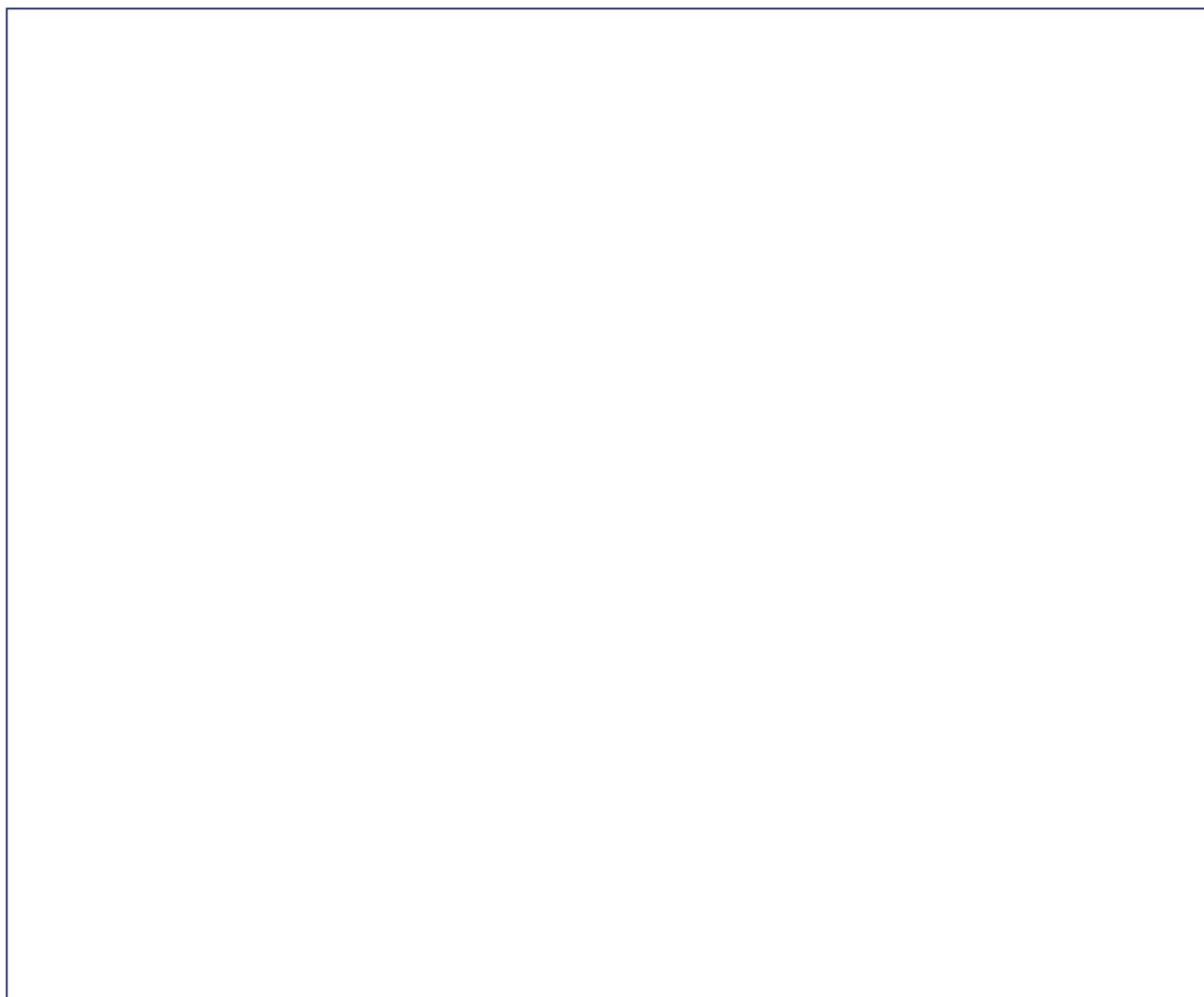


Rosa's French Opinion Café

Learning objective: To express likes and dislikes in French using opinion phrases and adjectives.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a French café! Use the vocabulary in the word bank to draw her favourite food items and label them with how she feels about them. Remember to include the correct French opinion phrase next to each item.

Draw: Create a bustling café scene on a table. In the centre, draw Rosa the parrot wearing a small French beret. Around her, draw four different food items from the word bank. Use speech bubbles coming from Rosa to display the opinion phrases (J'adore, J'aime, etc.) pointing towards each specific food item. Use a clean, colourful, cartoon-style illustration with clear labels for each item.



Label words: J'adore (I love) · J'aime (I like) · Je n'aime pas (I do not like) · Le chocolat (chocolate) · La pomme (apple) · Le fromage (cheese) · La glace (ice cream) · Délicieux (delicious) · Bof (so-so/not great)

Steps:

1. Draw a plate with 'le chocolat' and write the phrase 'J'adore le chocolat' underneath it.
2. Draw a piece of 'le fromage' and use the phrase 'Je n'aime pas le fromage' to show Rosa's opinion.
3. Add a 'la pomme' to your drawing and label it with 'J'aime la pomme'.
4. Translate the phrase 'C'est délicieux' into English.

5. If you wanted to say you love ice cream, which phrase from the word bank would you use?
