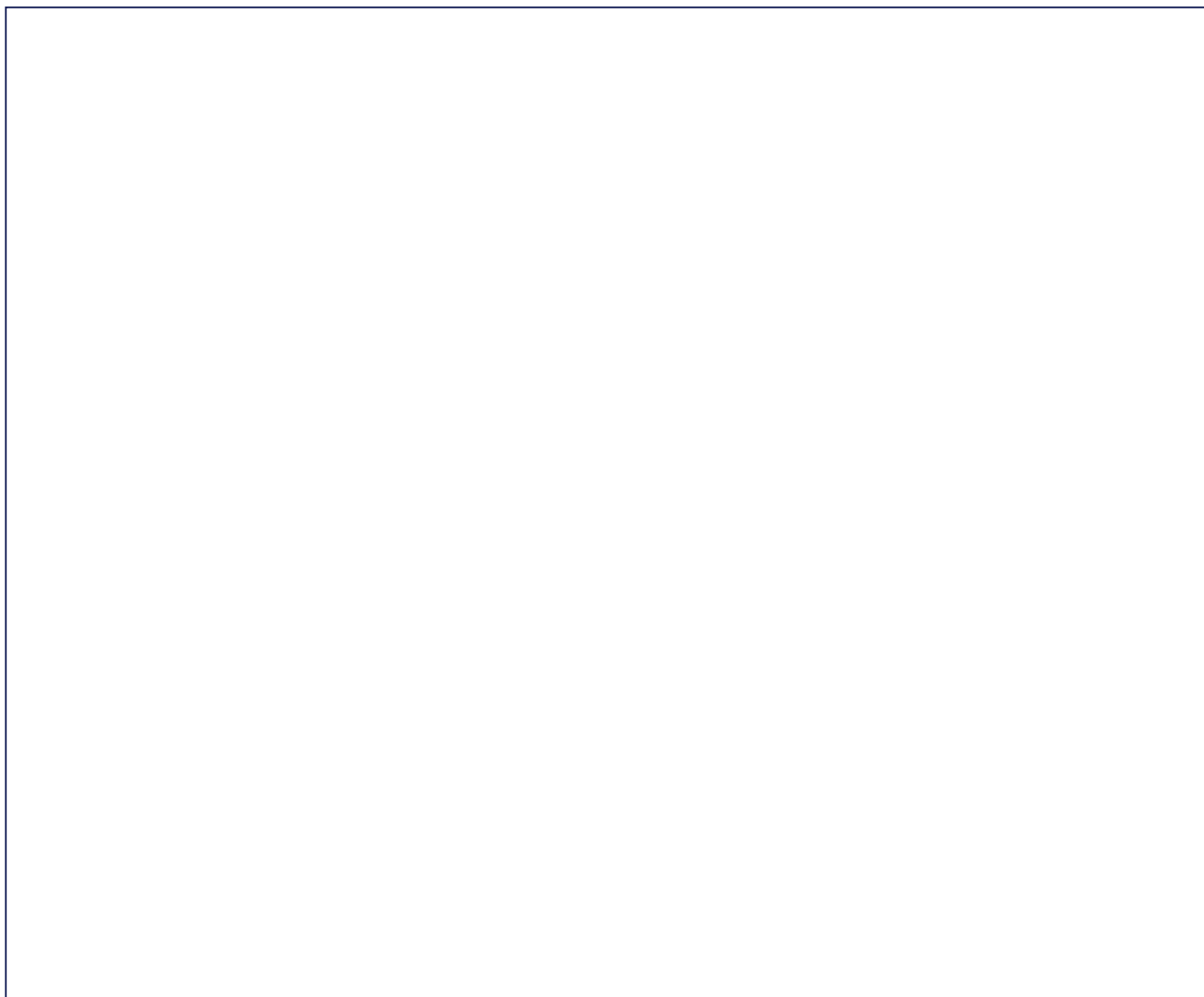


Ma Journée à l'École - My School Day

Learning objective: To identify and illustrate key vocabulary related to school subjects and classroom items in French.

Use your knowledge of French school vocabulary to label your drawing. Make sure your illustrations clearly represent each item listed in the word bank.

Draw: Create a detailed illustration of your ideal classroom. Include a main desk for the teacher, student desks, and shelves for books. In the background, draw a window looking out onto the playground. Use vibrant colours and ensure there is enough space around your objects to write the French labels clearly.



Label words: la trousse (pencil case) · le cahier (exercise book) · les maths (maths) · l'art (art) · la bibliothèque (library) · la cour de récréation (playground) · le professeur (teacher)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw your classroom scene. Include a teacher and at least three pieces of school equipment. Label these items using the correct French nouns from the word bank.
2. Step 2: Draw a speech bubble coming from the teacher. Write a short French phrase inside, such as 'Bonjour!' or 'Ouvrez vos cahiers' (Open your books).
3. Step 3: Which school subject is your favourite? Draw a small symbol representing that subject in the

corner of your page and label it in French.

4. Step 4: Draw a scene showing where you go during break time. Label this area in French.

5. Step 5: Explain in one sentence why you chose those specific items for your classroom scene.
