Learning objective: To identify and use French vocabulary for school subjects and express opinions about them.

Read each question carefully and write your answers in French where indicated. Use the word bank to help you with your spelling.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends talk about their favourite school subjects. Use the vocabulary provided to help them share their thoughts.

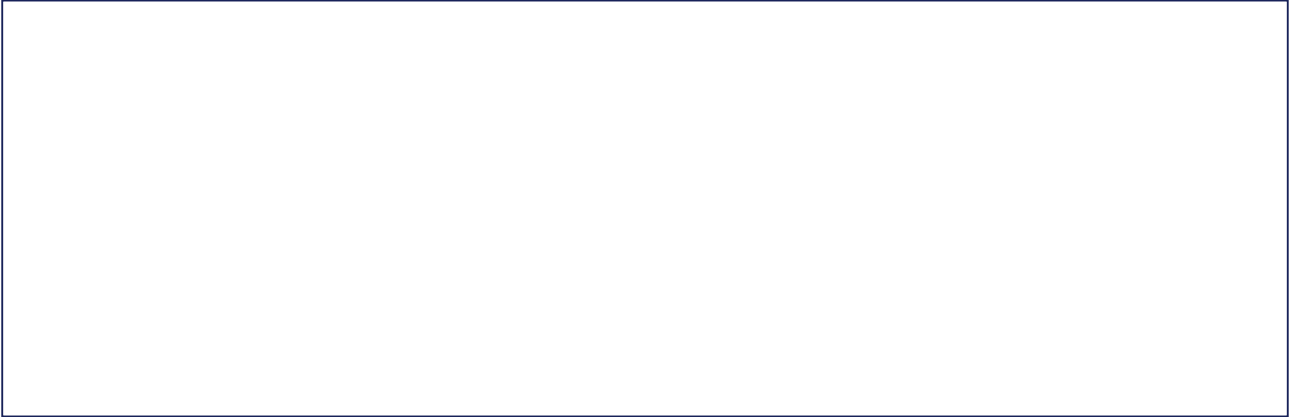
2. Translate the following sentence into French: 'I like science because it is fun.' (2 marks)
