

Rosa's Market Adventure: French Shopping Assessment

Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of French vocabulary related to food, prices, and polite shopping interactions.

Read each question carefully. Use the word bank to help you spell your French vocabulary. Write your answers clearly in English or French as requested.

Rosa the parrot has flown to a bustling French market. She is helping her friends buy ingredients for a picnic. She needs to ask the stallholders for prices and make sure she has enough money in her purse.

Word bank: la pomme (apple) · le pain (bread) · le fromage (cheese) · le chocolat (chocolate) · combien coûte...? · s'il vous plaît (please) · merci (thank you) · un euro (one euro) · deux euros (two euros) · c'est cher (it is expensive)

1. Rosa wants to ask the stallholder the price of a loaf of bread. Write the French phrase she should use. (2 marks)

2. Translate the following shopping list into French: 1. The apple, 2. The cheese. (2 marks)

3. If a bar of chocolate costs £2.00, how would you say 'two euros' in French? (Note: In this market, we use the currency term 'euros'). (2 marks)

4. Explain why it is important to say 's'il vous plaît' and 'merci' when shopping at a market in France. (4 marks)

5. Rosa sees a special cake that costs £10.00. She thinks it is too expensive. Write a short French sentence to express that it is expensive. (3 marks)

6. Imagine you are at the market with Rosa. Write a short dialogue (5 sentences total) between you and a stallholder. You must include a greeting, a request for an item, asking for the price, a polite 'thank you', and a farewell. (7 marks)

7. Extended Writing Task: Rosa has £15.00 to spend. She buys bread for £2.00, cheese for £4.00, and apples for £3.00. Write a paragraph in English describing how much she spent, how much change she received, and listing the items she bought in French. (5 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot sitting on a market stall filled with fruit and bread. Label three items in the drawing using their French names.
