

## Class 5 French: Les Sports et les Loisirs

*Learning objective: To demonstrate understanding of French vocabulary relating to sports, express preferences, and construct simple sentences about physical activities.*

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in the spaces provided. Remember to use your knowledge of French grammar and vocabulary.

Rosa the parrot is busy today! She is watching her friends play in the park. Max is playing football, while Pip is learning to swim. Zara is practising judo, and Leo is playing tennis. Rosa likes to cheer them on in French!

**1. Using the passage, identify which sport Max is playing and which sport Pip is doing. Write your answers in French. (2 marks)**

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**2. Translate these phrases into English: 'Je joue au tennis' and 'Je fais de la natation'. (2 marks)**

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**3. Fill in the blanks to complete the sentence: 'J'aime le basket parce que \_\_\_\_\_.'  
(Use an adjective from the word bank). (2 marks)**

**4. Why do we use 'au' for football but 'de la' for natation? Explain the rule briefly. (4 marks)**

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**5. Rosa wants to know about your favourite sport. Write 3 sentences in French describing a sport you like, a sport you do not like, and why. (5 marks)**

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6. Look at the list of sports: Le rugby, La gymnastique, Le vélo. Categorise these into sports using 'jouer' (to play) or 'faire' (to do). (5 marks)

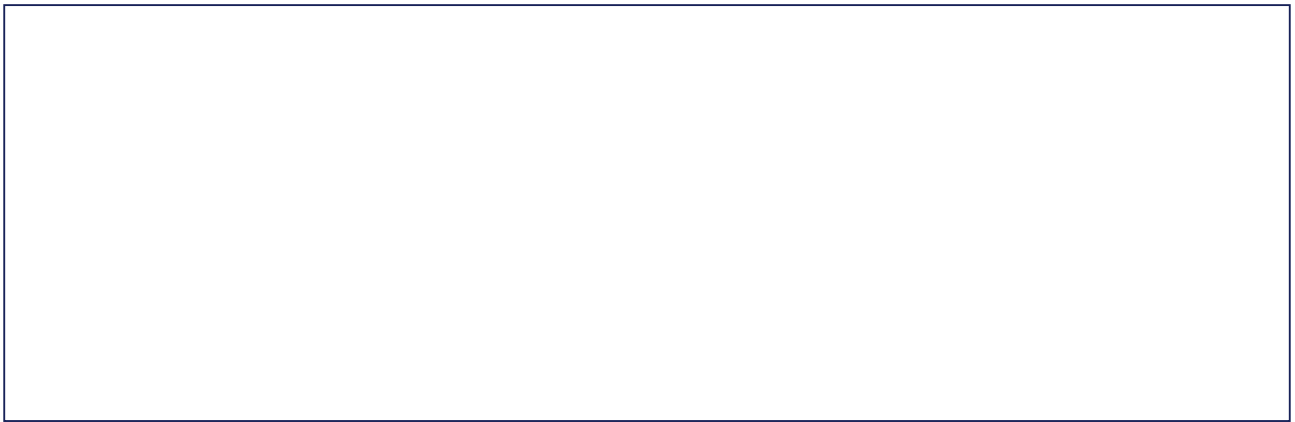
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7. Imagine you are teaching a friend how to say 'I play football' and 'I do judo'. Write the French phrases clearly. (5 marks)
