

Rosa's Time-Travelling Café

Learning objective: To tell the time in French using o'clock, half-past, and quarter-past/to (the hour).

Rosa the parrot is opening a café! Look at the clocks in the café and match the French time phrases to the correct clock face. Once matched, write the time in English underneath each one.

Word bank: Il est une heure · Il est deux heures et demie · Il est trois heures et quart · Il est quatre heures moins le quart · Il est cinq heures · Il est six heures et demie

1. Clock 1 shows 1:00. Which phrase fits? (2 marks)

2. Clock 2 shows 2:30. Which phrase fits? (2 marks)

3. Clock 3 shows 3:15. Which phrase fits? (2 marks)

4. Clock 4 shows 3:45. Which phrase fits? (2 marks)

5. Clock 5 shows 5:00. Which phrase fits? (2 marks)

6. Clock 6 shows 6:30. Which phrase fits? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a large clock face on the wall of Rosa's café. Set the hands to 'Il est dix heures et quart' (10:15) and draw Rosa the parrot waiting for customers.

Extension challenge: Rosa wants to bake a cake that takes 'une heure' (one hour) to cook. If she puts it in the oven at 'neuf heures' (9:00), what time will it be ready? Write your answer in French.
