

Rosa's French Transport Adventure

Learning objective: To learn and use French vocabulary for different modes of transport and express opinions using 'je préfère' (I prefer).

Rosa the parrot is planning a journey across France! Look at the word bank to find the correct French words for each mode of transport. Match the French term to the English description, then write a full sentence in French explaining which one you prefer using the phrase: 'Je préfère le/la/l'...' (I prefer the...).

Word bank: le train · le vélo · la voiture · le bus · l'avion · le bateau

1. Match the French word to its English meaning: 1. Le train, 2. Le vélo, 3. La voiture, 4. Le bus, 5. L'avion, 6. Le bateau. (6 marks)

2. Rosa wants to fly to Paris. Which word from the bank should she use? (1 mark)

3. Write a sentence in French saying: 'I prefer the train'. (2 marks)

4. Write a sentence in French saying: 'I prefer the bike'. (2 marks)

5. If a train ticket costs £15.50 and a bus ticket costs £4.25, how much would it cost for one person to travel by both? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot travelling in your favourite mode of transport. Label the mode of transport in French.



Extension challenge: Research one famous French city. Write a short sentence explaining how you would travel there from the UK (e.g., 'Je voyage en train' or 'Je voyage en avion').
