

Rosa's French Verb Adventure!

Get ready to speak like a pro – master your French verbs with Rosa the parrot!

- The infinitive is the base form of the verb, like 'parler' (to speak).
- The subject pronoun 'je' means 'I', and 'tu' means 'you'.
- To conjugate an -er verb, we remove the -er and add a new ending.
- For 'je' (I), the verb ending usually changes to -e.
- For 'tu' (you), the verb ending usually changes to -es.
- Practising these patterns helps you build sentences to describe your day!

Did you know? Did you know? In French, most verbs end in -er. When we change the ending to match the person speaking, it is called 'conjugation'. It is like a secret code that tells you exactly who is performing the action!
