

Rosa's Verb Voyage: Mastering French Tenses

Learning objective: To identify and use common French verbs in the present tense, focusing on regular -er verbs and the irregular verbs 'être' (to be) and 'avoir' (to have).

Rosa the parrot is preparing for a trip across France! Help her pack her suitcase by matching the correct verb form to the subject pronoun. Choose the right verb from the word bank to complete the sentences below. Remember to ensure the verb ending matches the person doing the action.

2. Max says: 'Nous ____ un grand sac pour le voyage.' (We have a big bag for the trip.) (2 marks)

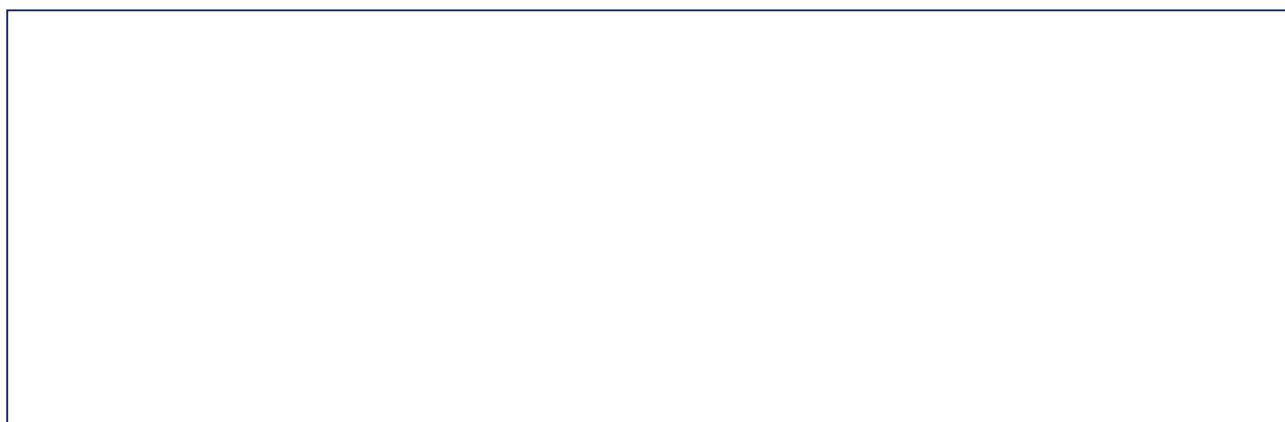
3. Pip says: 'Il ____ une pomme rouge.' (He eats a red apple.) (2 marks)

6. Kit says: 'Vous ____ au football dans le parc.' (You (plural) play football in the park.) (2 marks)
