

Rosa's Weather Report: Le Bulletin Météo

Learning objective: To be able to identify and use French vocabulary to describe common weather conditions.

Rosa the parrot is preparing a weather report for her friends. Look at the weather icons provided in the drawing prompt section. Match the correct French weather phrase from the word bank to the icon and write it in the space provided. Then, write a sentence in French explaining how you feel in that specific weather.

Word bank: Il fait beau · Il pleut · Il fait froid · Il y a du soleil · Il y a du vent · Il neige

1. Icon 1 (A bright sun): Write the French phrase and a sentence about how you feel. (2 marks)

2. Icon 2 (Rain clouds): Write the French phrase and a sentence about how you feel. (2 marks)

3. Icon 3 (A snowflake): Write the French phrase and a sentence about how you feel. (2 marks)

4. Icon 4 (Windy trees): Write the French phrase and a sentence about how you feel. (2 marks)

5. Icon 5 (A thermometer showing low temperature): Write the French phrase and a sentence about how you feel. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw five small weather symbols: a sun, a rain cloud, a snowflake, a tree blowing in the wind, and a thermometer with a low reading. Label each one with the correct French phrase from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Imagine you are a weather presenter on television. Write a short script in French telling your friends what the weather is like in three different cities, using the phrases you have learned today.
