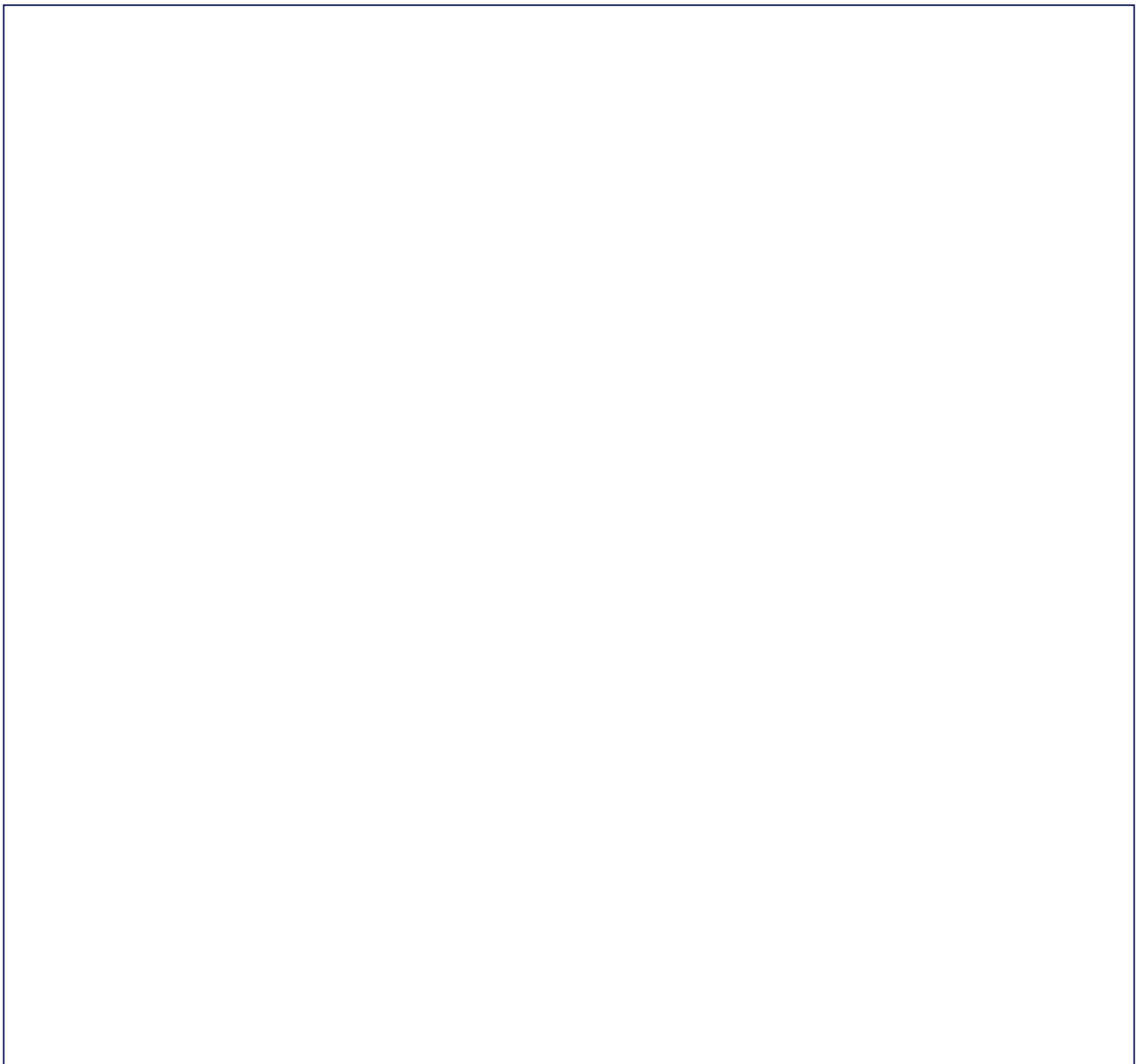


Finn's Climate Adventure

Learning objective: To identify different weather patterns and seasonal changes in our environment.

Look at the picture below! Finn the dolphin is exploring the world and seeing different types of weather. Can you colour in the sun, the rain clouds, and the snowy mountains? Think about what colours we see when it is sunny, rainy, or cold.
