

Finn's Climate Adventure

Learning objective: To understand that different parts of the world have different climates, including hot, cold, and rainy weather.

Look at the pictures and think about the weather. Help Finn the dolphin match the clothes and activities to the right type of weather.

Finn the dolphin is swimming around the world map. Sometimes he visits places that are very hot and sunny, and sometimes he visits places that are icy, cold, and snowy. Weather is what it is like outside today, but climate is the weather a place has for a very long time.

Word bank: sunny · snowy · rainy · hot · cold · coat · hat · sun-hat

1. Finn is visiting a place with lots of ice and snow. Should he wear his sun-hat or his warm woolly hat? Why? (2 marks)

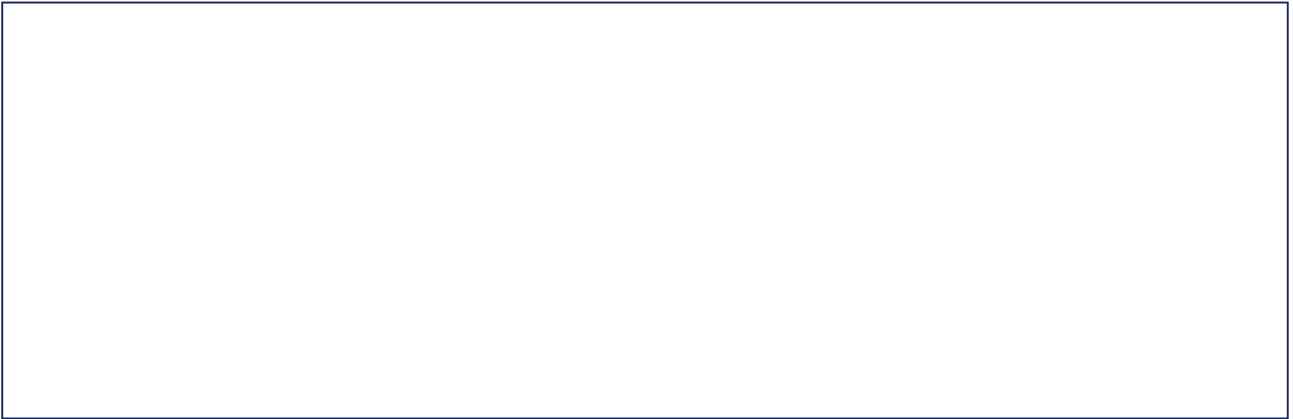
2. If a place is very sunny and hot all year round, what might you wear to stay cool? (1 mark)

3. Draw a line to match the weather to the item: Rainy weather needs a... (1 mark)

4. If you are playing outside and it starts to rain, what do you need to wear to keep dry? (1 mark)

5. Is it better to go to the beach when it is snowy or when it is sunny? Tell me why. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of yourself playing outside in your favourite type of weather. Are you wearing wellies for the rain, or shorts for the sunshine?



Extension challenge: Imagine you are going on holiday with Finn. If you had £5 to spend at the seaside, would you buy an ice cream for £2 or a bucket and spade for £3? How much money would you have left?
