- The Equator is an imaginary line that circles the middle of the Earth, dividing it into the Northern and Southern Hemispheres.
- Asia is the largest continent by both land area and population, stretching across a vast portion of the globe.
- The Southern Ocean was officially recognised by geographers as the fifth ocean in the year 2000.

Did you know? Did you know? Even though we have five named oceans, they are actually all connected! This massive body of saltwater is often referred to as the 'Global Ocean', covering over 70% of the Earth's surface.
