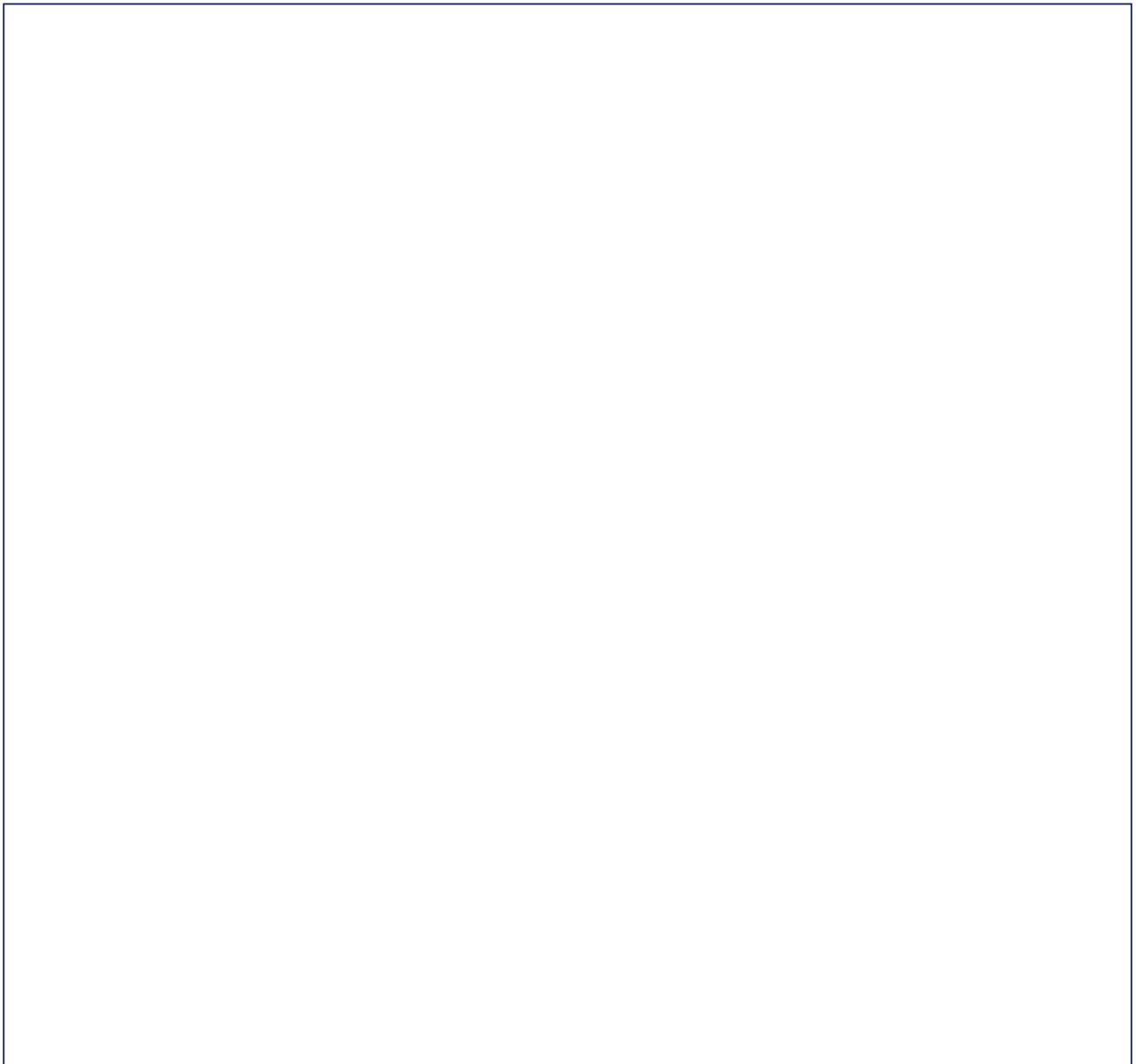


Finn's Big Blue World

Learning objective: To identify that the world is made up of large land masses called continents and large areas of water called oceans.

Look at the map and colour in the continents and oceans. Can you help Finn the Dolphin label the different parts of the map?

Colour this: A simple, child-friendly world map showing the outlines of the seven continents. In the middle of the Pacific Ocean, draw Finn the Dolphin smiling and wearing a small explorer's hat. Surrounding the continents are wavy lines representing the oceans. Include simple outlines for a compass rose in the corner. Keep the continent shapes distinct so they are easy for children to colour with different crayons.



Steps:

1. Label the land masses called 'Continents' in your picture.
2. Label the large areas of blue water called 'Oceans' in your picture.
