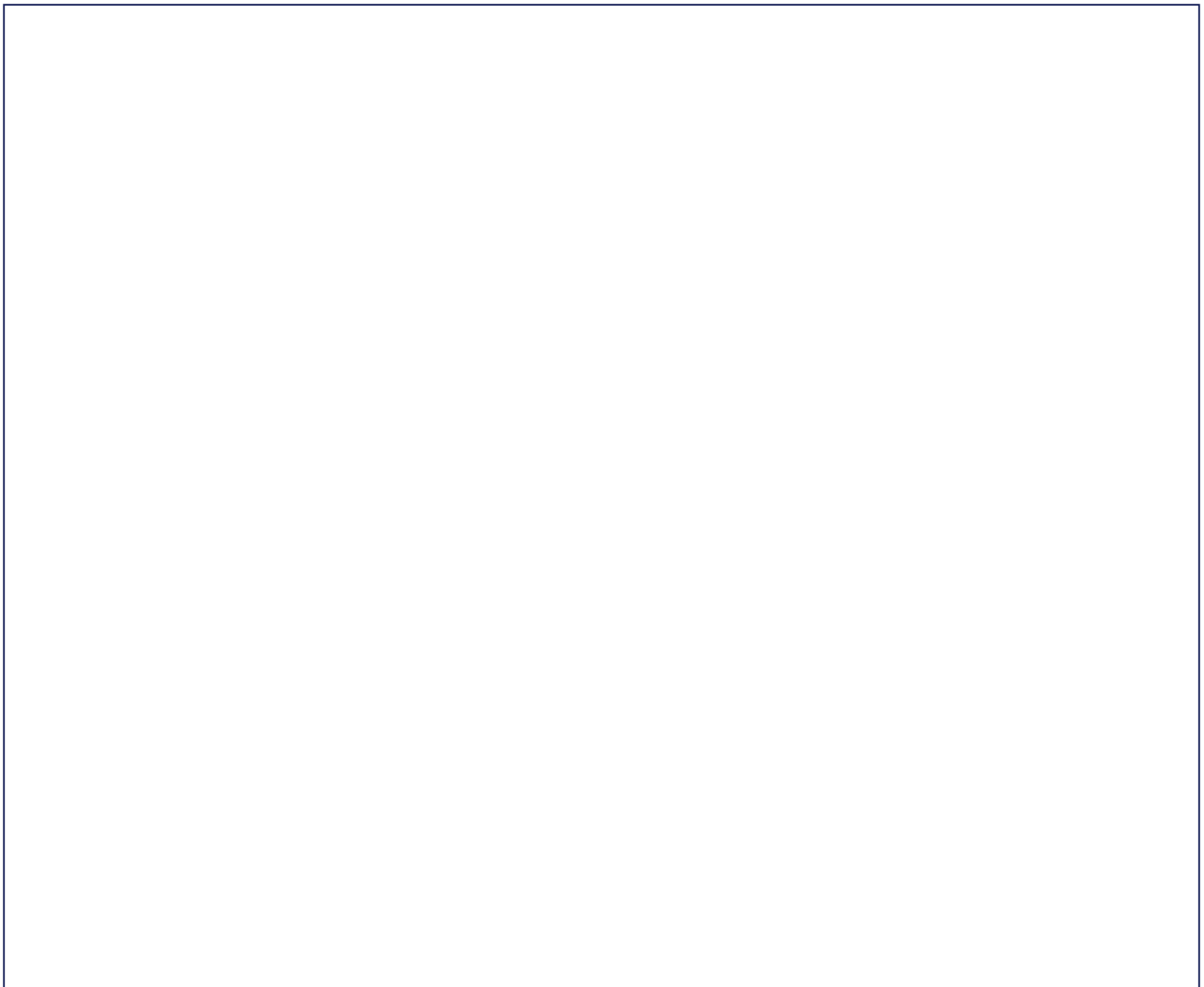


Finn's Geography Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and distinguish between physical features (natural) and human features (man-made) in our environment.

Look at the list of words below. Choose some to add to your picture to show the difference between things that are natural and things that people have built.

Draw: Draw a large landscape scene. Include a winding river and a tall mountain to represent physical geography. Add a small village with a road, a house, and a bridge crossing the river to represent human geography. Use bright colours and clear outlines.



Label words: river · house · mountain · road · tree · bridge · shop · beach

Steps:

2. Which of your drawings is a physical feature made by nature? Write the name here.
3. Which of your drawings is a human feature made by people? Write the name here.
