

Finn's Geography Explorer Fact-File

Learning objective: To identify and describe key features of human and physical geography in the local area.

Join Finn the dolphin on an adventure to look at the world around you! Walk outside with an adult and look for things made by people (human geography) and things made by nature (physical geography). Use this fact-file to record what you find.

Word bank: river · tree · house · shop · park · road · hill · bridge · bench · fountain

1. My Physical Geography Discovery: Name a natural thing you see outside (like a tree or a hill). Why do you think it is there? (2 marks)

2. My Human Geography Discovery: Name something built by people (like a shop or a house). What do people use it for? (2 marks)

3. The Weather Today: What is the weather like while you are exploring? Is it sunny, rainy, or windy? (1 mark)

4. Shopping Trip: If you went to a shop, what is one thing you saw for sale? How many £ coins would you need to buy a small treat? (2 marks)

5. My Favourite Spot: Where is the best place in your local area to play or relax? Why do you like it? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Draw a map of the route you took today. Can you mark your favourite 'Human' feature with a blue star and your favourite 'Physical' feature with a green circle?
