

Finn's Volcanic Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and name the basic physical features of a volcano and understand how the Earth changes.

Help Finn the dolphin learn about the land! Use the word bank to label the parts of the volcano you draw.

Draw: Draw a large triangular mountain in the centre of your page. At the very top, draw a crater with bright orange and red squiggles to show hot lava flowing down the side. Add a dark grey cloud of smoke and ash rising into the sky. At the bottom of the page, draw a blue wavy line to show the sea where Finn the dolphin is watching safely.



Label words: lava · mountain · ash · smoke

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a big triangle shape for the mountain. What is the name of this mountain shape?
2. Step 2: Draw some squiggly lines coming out of the top. These are hot 'lava'. Where does the lava come from?
3. Step 3: Label the grey cloud at the top of your volcano using the word 'ash'. Why do you think it is grey?
4. Step 4: Draw Finn the dolphin swimming in the sea near the volcano. Is the volcano on land or in the water?
5. Step 5: If you visited a volcano, would you stay far away or go very close? Why?
